Continued

Last part steady with fresh breezes from WNW heading to NW saw a sail all hands hauling, lowering down and setting up shrouks & boom as Jenkins off duty still

No obs

Sunday July 25 1847

Cont'd with cloudy weather and fresh breezes from WNW heading to NW steering down and sailing closed down at 6 PM

Middle part cloudy with light breezes from WNW heading to NW

Last part cloudy with fresh breezes from WNW heading to NW saw a sail and a pulch all starting down set through steering and began to blow off at 10 AM in the afternoon took peace and water when Jenkins off duty still

Latitude by obs 33° 09' north

Longitude by chron 107° 35' W

Monday July 26 1847

Cont'd with cloudy weather and fresh breezes from WNW heading to NW, employed in lowering down a dead whale at 3 PM took him to the ship and began to cut at 4 PM saw one side of the hump and lost the throat



Middle part cloudy with thick fog and light breezes from WNW setting

Last part thick fog and cloudy with light breezes from WNW heading to NW got through at 6 AM and took a watch below boom & Jenkins off duty still

Latitude by obs 32° 55' north

Longitude by chron 107° 25' W

Tuesday July 27 1847

Cont'd with cloudy weather and light breezes from WNW heading to NW saw two sail one hauling spoke the ship General Dexte of Haven 10 whales 9 as obs began to hail at 2 PM

Middle part cloudy and light breezes from WNW heading to NW

Last part fine but cloudy weather and light breezes from WNW heading to NW hauling and breaking out shrouks and with the General & Jenkins off duty took the fresh Doctor to him for blood then and gave him some medicine for their pain

Latitude by obs 32° 48' north

Wednesday July 28 1847

Cont'd with fine but cloudy weather and light breezes from WNW heading to NW all hands employed in hauling and breaking out shrouks and setting them up exchanged some line with the General & Jenkins came here in the evening paid some dry goods to the steward

Middle part cloudy and foggy weather and light breezes from WNW heading to NW

Last part thick fog and light breezes from WNW heading to NW saw ship Wainwright Howell New Bedford 17 AM 11 whales this season & Jenkins off duty still

Latitude by obs 32° 04' north

Thursday July 29 1847

Cont'd with a thick fog and light breezes from WNW heading to NW saw fisher sailing at 2 PM two passed at night

Middle part light air and fog Last part thick fog and light breezes from WNW heading to NW saw a pulch started down in the afternoon on the label side of Jenkins and down with the ship

Friday July 30 1847

Cont'd with thick fog and light breezes from WNW heading to NW saw a sail finished steering took in the down top sail and still
