

Barque Cherokee towards Swan Charlotte Island
Monday August 23 1847

382 *Cont^d* with cloudy weather and
hisk breezes from N.W. steering E.N.E. all hands boiling
cleaning some setting up shooks & C. hauled the fore top
sail at 6 1/2 P.M. and hauled to N.N.E.

Middle part cloudy with brisk breezes
from N.W. steering to N.N.E. by the wind boiling.

Last part cloudy with some fog and
hisk breezes from N.W. heading by the wind back way
saw a gam of three right whales several two boats to
no purpose saw a gam of 5 or 7 several two boats again
saw one and several the starboard boat all to no purpose
saw some other all hands boiling setting up shooks and
breaking out the fore peak & sinkers and scuttles off duty

Tuesday August 24 1847

383 *Cont^d* with cloudy weather and some fog
and brisk breezes from N.W. heading by the wind back way
all hands boiling and steering down in the fore peak
saw a gam of three right whales several three boats to
no purpose saw others

Middle part cloudy with fog and
light breezes from N.W. heading to N.E. by the wind

Last part cloudy with fog and
light breezes from N.W. heading to N.E. by the wind
cooled down at 6 A.M. all hands steering down in
the fore peak sinkers and scuttles and John C. Leicester off duty

Wednesday August 25 1847

384 *Cont^d* with cloudy weather with
some fog and light breezes from N.W. heading to N.E. by the
wind finished steering down sail at 8 P.M. spoke
Barque Iris Hargnes & whales he was boiling

Middle part cloudy with fog and
light breezes from E.S.E. heading to N.E.

Last part cloudy with light breezes
from E.S.E. heading to N.E. by the wind all hands
saw the Iris John C. Leicester and John C. Leicester off duty

Thursday August 26 1847

Cont^d with fair but cloudy weather
and light breezes from E.S.E. heading to N.E. saw the
Iris and a right whale several three boats the
starboard boat struck the L.B. killed and took
him to the ship at 6 1/2 P.M. hooked on anchor

the Eastward made sail to suit the times cleared the head
and decks saw some finbacks John C. Leicester and John C.

Friday August 27 1847

386 *Cont^d* with fine weather and light
breezes from E to N heading to Eastward cleared the
fore and cut blubber saw finbacks porpoises Blackfish
and a right whale giving quick did not touch spoke
Barque Iris Hargnes 1300 on board had sold 1300 before



Middle part cloudy with light breezes
from N heading to the Eastward

Last part fair but cloudy weather
and light breezes from N.E. heading to E.S.E. saw the
Iris and finbacks cut up the blubber John C. Leicester and
James Christy off duty and Daniel M. Sadler
