Monday August 29 1847

Contine with fine but cloudy weather and
 light breezes from S W heading to E Watch boiling
 and setting up shacks two reefed at night

 breezes from N W steering to E N E boiling

Last part cloudy with light breezes
 from N W steering E N E boiling John & Jenkins James
 Christy & Henry How off duty

Monday August 30 1847

Contine with cloudy weather and light
 breezes from N W steering E N E saw a dead whale but
 good he had busted gut through and cooled down at
 7 PM took in sail and hauled to N N E

 from N W heading to N N E by the wind

Last part cloudy but fine weather
 and light breezes from N W to W steering N E, steered
 down in the dark peak and hole John & Jenkins
 James Christy & Henry How off duty still

Latitude by obs 51° 21' north

Longitude per Chron 133° 15' west

Tuesday August 31 1847

Contine with fine but cloudy weather
 and light breezes from N W to S W finished steering
 down at 6 PM two reefed and hauled to S S E

Contine Middle part cloudy foggy with light breezes
 from S W steering by the wind to S S E

Last part cloudy and foggy with light
 breezes from N N W made all sail and steered S W saw a
 finback John & Jenkins James Christy & Henry How off duty still

Longitude per Chron 133° 15' west

Wednesday September 1 1847

Contine with fine weather and light
 breezes from N N W steering to S W to S S E saw a Siberian
 covered three boats to no purpose saw a finback two reefed
 at night

Middle part light breezes from N W and
 cloudy weather steered to S E

Last part fine weather and light
 breezes from N W steering S E all drawing sail, set John &
 Jenkins James Christy & Henry How off duty still

Longitude per Chron 133° 15' west

Thursday September 2 1847

Contine with fine weather and light
 breezes from the Westward steering S E carried sail and
 floored whole watches

Middle part cloudy with light breezes
 from S W steering to S E by the wind

Last part thick fog and light breezes
 from S W steering to S E by the wind longer making seas
 John & Jenkins James Christy and Henry How off duty still
 No obs this day

Friday September 3 1847

Contine with thick fog and light breezes
 from S W steering to S E

Middle part foggy with light
 breezes from N W steering to S E by 3/4 E

Last part thick fog and light breezes
 from N W to W steering S E by 3/4 E set a vine top mast
 furling sail longer making seas John & Jenkins
