and light trades steered ship in

Middle part fine weather and
light trades steered ship in

Last part fine but cloudy with
light trades steered ship in & made more ahead and
brought three points off the Larched horn at 6 P.M.
the stowage down top fell mast & sink in off duty
Latitude by obs 30.56 north

Thursday September 28 1847

Cont. with fine weather and
light trades steered ship in & at 30 fathoms of the
staked cable and 20 of the Larched part both sinkers
in the shoes at 6 P.M. in the east end of the Larched
mistake sheast of 10 miles distant took in
studs main royal

Middle part fine but cloudy
with light trades steered ship in the passage and
by came to at 6 P.M. in 25 fathoms of
water and 45 fathoms of cable on the staked
horn got two raft in place & sink in
off duty still afternoon painted some in
the waist so ends their 26 hours

Friday October 1 1847

All this day fine weather and rain
421 breezes from all parts took the March and stowed
in means to the passing and came to in 10 fathoms
of water got off 29 cask of water and healed the
ship cleavingal & sink in on the compasses

At Anchor in Maui Jacob L Cleveland Master
Saturday October 3 1847

All this day fine weather and
light breezes from all parts painted the bends on
the Larched side the Larched watch on liberty sent
the Carpenter on shore to get repaired

Sunday October 4 1847

All this day fine weather and light
breezes from the eastward the Larched watch on liberty
Monday October 4 1847

All this day fine weather and light
breezes painted the Larched bends the Larched watch on
liberty

Tuesday October 5 1847

All this day fine weather and light
breezes from various parts sighted ship and stowed
water in the June Hele the Larched watch on liberty
Michael Muller did not come on board with the water
Wednesday October 6 1847

All this day fine weather and light
breezes Michael Muller came on board got in a river
put him in the rigging and gave him a small flogging
put him in sun and striking at him stowed water sent
a raft in place got 21 lbs potatoes and some pumpkins
the Larched watch on liberty

Thursday October 7 1847

All this day fine weather and light
breezes got a small raft and stowed it put up the Webstays
the Larched watch on liberty painted a part of the stern
Friday October 8 1847

All this day fine weather and light
breezes the Larched watch on liberty painted the
stern and got 30 lbs potatoes some bananas
Saturday October 9 1847

All this day fine weather and light
breezes the Larched watch on liberty got 10 lbs sweet potatoes
and 10 men to go the cruise of Hancock & Spangore
two partridges and two larks
