

Barque Cherokee from Miami and to Oahu
Sunday October 10 1847

All this day fine weather and
430 light breezes got our anchor and stood out
drifted round with the tide trying to go between
Munster and rain.

Monday October 11 1847

Ran with fine weather and small
breezes for N E steering clear towards Linn Hill

Middle part fine weather and
light breezes ran on fair and the ship

Last part fine weather and light
431 breezes at 4 P M got off the hill and had a light
breeze for N.W. steering well by the wind at 5 P M
the shipping in the harbor and one lying off at
at sundown Linn Hill about 10 miles distant
by day and on

Tuesday October 13 1847

Ran with fine weather and brisk
trades stood in and came to at 9 A M in 32 fathoms
of water half way for Linn Hill to the passage and
two miles from the reef cleared our bow 104 fathoms

433 on board ship but we had some trouble of and for
passage lay with the starboard bow and 60 fathoms
of chain

Wednesday October 13 1847

Ran with fine weather and
light breezes for the land the light on shore to the

435 this morning so and there 12 hours of the civil day
Thursday October 14

Ran with fine weather and
variable breezes for the land got under weigh
at 4 P M and stood off to the N.W. to clear the land

434 Middle part fine weather
and light air for the land

Last part fine weather and
calm ran from 12 or 15 miles from the land
sat up sun of the vessel seen one Kanaka off

Ran with fine weather and a calm
at 6 P M a small breeze for N E steering
435 N.W. by the

Middle part fine weather and light
breezes for N E steering N.W. by the

Last part fine weather and light
breezes for the Eastward at daylight observed off the shore
from 12 or 15 miles hauled up and at 8 A M
the light and second mate with their crew went on
shore put up the lower rigging for and off one Kanaka off

Latitude 33° 44' north

Saturday October 16 1847

Ran with fine weather and
nearly calm the boat returned at 5 P M with
11 boys and 4 fowls

Middle part fine weather and
light breezes and calm working to S

Last part fine weather and light
breezes for S E heading to S.W. steered the Linn
cable and put up head stays one Kanaka off ship
the land 12 or 15 miles off Latitude 33° 52' north

Longitude 159° 30'

Sunday October 17 1847

Ran with fine weather and light
breezes for S E steering to S.W. by the wind steered
the starboard anchor and cable put up the head stays

437

Middle part cloudy with brisk
breezes for S E heading to S.W.

Last part cloudy with brisk breezes
for S E heading to S.W. one Kanaka off ship
all present sail set

Latitude by obs 33° 50' north

Longitude by obs 161° 02' W

Monday October 18 1847

Ran with cloudy weather and
brisk breezes for S E heading to S.W.
