Friday October 22 1847

at the main and mended the fly dill

Middle part cloudy with brisk
breezes from E N E steering to S S E by the wind

Last part fine but cloudy with
brisk breezes from E N E steering to S S E mended the
fly dill sent down the studds boards one Kanacka off duty
Latitude by obs 10° 08' north
Longitude from Chron 161° 40' W

Saturday October 23 1847

443 Part with fine but cloudy weather
and light breezes from E N E steering to S S E

Middle part fine weather and
light breezes from W steering to S S E

Last part cloudy with variable
breezes course S S E painted the Starboard boat two Kanackas
John Brown and Bill off duty with the general orders
Latitude by obs 7° 30' north

Sunday October 24 1847

444 Part with cloudy weather and
light variable breezes with some rain course S S E

Middle part fine but cloudy
with light breezes and calms

Last part fine but cloudy with
light breezes from the eastward course S S E Bill
and John Brown off duty still

Latitude by obs 9° 00' north
Longitude from Chron 161° 10' W
