Com<sup>d</sup> with cloudy weather and  
light breezes from E S E steering to S by the wind.  
Saw porpoises killed a dog

with calm. Bill and John Brown off duty

Thursday October 28 1847

Com<sup>d</sup> with cloudy rainy weather  
and calm at 6 P M a fresh breeze from E S E  
took in top galls and two reefed the top sails.  
Hauled in crew and killed a fish breeder and

Saturday October 30 1847

Com<sup>d</sup> with fine but cloudy weather  
and light breezes from S E steering to S S W by the wind.  
Hauled top galls at sundown

Middle part fine weather and  
light breezes from S E heading to S S W and S E

Last part fine weather and  
light breezes from S E heading to S E. Bill and John  
Brown off duty still

Latitude by obs 4° 45' north

Sunday October 31 1847

Com<sup>d</sup> with fine but cloudy weather  
and light breezes from S E heading to S S W

Middle part cloudy with fresh  
breezes from S E carried away the visible gear

Last part cloudy with strong  
breezes hauled top galls steered by the wind  
to S S E. Bill and John Brown off duty still
