not get up to them before dark killed a boy

light breezes from E & E steered to N at 1
P.M. tacked to S S E by the wind

light breezes from E & E heading to S E at
9 A.M. saw a shoal of sperm whales lowered
at 10 1/2 A.M. and the Larbord Mast struck one
and killed it with the arrow the waist boat struck
and killed one

470 Com^d with fine weather and
light breezes from E & E took the whales along side
and began to cut at 3 P.M. got through and
bowed forward at 6 Made fail to N by the wind
Middle part fine weather and
light breezes from E & E cleared the head band
tacked at 1 A.M. began to bail at 3 A.M.
Last part fine weather and light
breezes from E & E heading to S E by the wind
bailing four pairs

Latitude 1.45° South
Longitude per Chron^r 169° 35'

Saturday November 20 1847

471 Com^d with fine weather and
light breezes from E & E headed to S E bailing
tacked at 6 1/2 P.M. to N

Middle part fine weather
and light breezes from E & E steered to N bailing
Last part fine weather and
light breezes from E & E finished bailing at 8 A.M.
Latitude by obs 1.03° S
Longitude per Chron^r 169° 31' W

Sunday November 21 1847

Middle part nearly calm
Last part fine weather and small
breezes from E & E headed to N E
