 Latitude by obs 10° 06' miles South
 Longitude per Chron 171° 00' E

502 Wednesday December 22 1847

Cont^d with fine weather and
 light breezes from N E headed to N N W
 we saw porpoises hauled top Galls at night

Middle part fine weather and
 light breezes from E N E headed both ways

Last part fine weather and
 light breezes from E N E made sail and steered
 S by S by the wind, mended S by S till saw
 porpoises Bill & John Brown off duty
 Latitude by obs 45 miles South
 Longitude per Chron 171° 00' E

503 Thursday December 23 1847

Cont^d with fine weather and
 light breezes from E N E steering to S by the
 wind about the spanker & main spanker
 and cut them up but a new spanker

Line Jacob L Cleveland Master
 Continued mended top galls S by S till at night

Middle part fine weather and
 light breezes from E N E steered to S E by the wind

Last part fine weather and
 light breezes from E N E steered to S E saw
 Blackfish hauls dumpbacks & C began to
 repair the fore top Galls Bill & John Brown off duty
 Latitude by obs 11° 06' South
 Longitude per Chron 171° 00' E

504 Friday December 24 1847

Cont^d with fine weather and
 light breezes from E N E steered to S E saw porpoise
 hauled top Galls

Middle part fine weather
 and small airs & calms

Last part fine weather and
 light breezes from N and calms finished and
 bent the fore top Galls bent the new fore course
 and mended the old to repair John and Bill
 off duty saw a turtle
 Latitude by obs 11° 01' South
 Longitude per Chron 170° 30' E

505 Saturday December 25 1847

Cont^d with fine weather and
 light breezes from N mending all fore course
 took in top Galls & steered up the courses

Middle part fine weather and
 light breezes from N W steered to N E

Last part fine weather and
 light breezes from N W steered to N E mended fore
 course Bill and John off duty still
 Latitude by obs 11° 01' South
 Longitude per Chron 170° 47' E

506 Sunday December 26 1847

 and took hauled top galls at night
