528 Monday January 17 1848

Cont^d with fine weather and light breezes
from N E & calms cut in the Boat took in the dunn and
bailed the Case parted a Cowen Block that saw a part of
some Seal

Middle part fine weather and light
breezes from N E and calms Bailed

Last part fine weather and mostly
calm cut in the small whale cleaved Head Case and
cleaved the Saws & C put the topsails & dunn at noon
and N E headed to N N W Boiling Sea Beem and
Nicholas off duty still

529 Tuesday January 18 1848

Cont^d with fine weather and light breezes
from N E headed to N N W Bailed some fishhooks set up
sharks

Middle part fine weather and
light breezes from N E steered to N N W Boiling

Last part fine weather and brisk
breezes from N E steered to N N W Boiling saw a
pair of seals Beem and Nicholas off duty still set up sharks

530 Wednesday January 19 1848

Cont^d with fine weather and
brisk breezes from N E steered to N N W by the wind
Boiling & setting up sharks

Middle part fine weather and light
breezes from E N E steered to S E by the wind & bailed

Last part fine weather and light
breezes from E N E steered to S E by the wind cut dunn
and bailed the Masts of the dunn steered of St Johns
cannon Beem and reported 14 00 Spruce and 5 00 miles
Capt Dick Capt Clubb went on board with Beem and
Nicholas & Antone Gonsells off duty still

531 Thursday January 20 1848

Cont^d with fine weather and light
breezes from E N E steered to S E saw the dunn & could
not take the head so badly blasted & missed it
and put it in cask to run out in the sun
and the oil in the jets and cooled down at 12 m set
in cask saw Beem Island at 6 PM off the land

Middle part fine weather and light breezes
from E N E steered to S E till daylight & tacked to N

Last part fine weather and light breezes
from E N E steered to N by the wind saw Beem Island
off the Sea and a carcass all hands steering down in
the dunn hole John Brown Nicholas & Antone Gonsells
off duty the Carpenter & Bob not much better

Longitude per Chron 169 44 E

532 Friday January 21 1848

Cont^d with fine weather and brisk breezes
from E N E steered to N by the wind saw Beem Island
steering down in the dunn hole handed up galls both
2 m fully

Middle part fine weather and
light breezes from E N E steered to N saw a pair

Last part fine weather and light
breezes from E N E steered to N & hand sail steering
down in the dunn hole John Brown Nicholas and
Antone off duty still

Latitude by obs 44 North

Longitude per Chron 169 44 E

533 Saturday January 22 1848

Cont^d with fine weather and light
breezes from E N E steered to S E by the wind steering
down the oil and filled the three remaining casks
in the pump tin with salt water washed off & c
