breezes from ENE steered to SE by the wind saw Ocean
Island paper and a full moon

Middle part fine weather and
light breezes from ENE steered to NNE by the wind
from 12 P.M.

Last part fine weather and light
breezes from NE headed to NNE by the wind
made a black strap from an old penstock cooper
mending cask bailed for oil from the cask and
put it in a jar John & Nicholas off duty still

556 Tuesday January 25 1848

light breezes from NE steered to NNE by the wind

breezes and calms & cloudy wind from NE course in
John Brown Nicholas and Charles Hanning off duty

light breezes from NE steered to NNE took the dories
