

566 Barque Cherokee at Apra Island of Guam
Wednesday February 22 1848

Came with moderate breezes
from N E to E sent the Lashed watch on duty of
4 days Peter came on board at 5 P M got off three
boat loads of wood cut and stored it when
Brewer on duty to day Middle and last part wind
and weather in continuance

567 Wednesday February 23 1848

Came with brisk breezes from E to
N E with rain at intervals got off three boat loads
of wood cut and stored it put Hole Middle
and last part wind and weather in continuance

568 Thursday February 24 1848

Came with fine weather and
brisk breezes from N E to E got off three boat
loads of wood and stored it Middle and last
part wind and weather in continuance

569 Friday February 25 1848

Came with fine weather and
brisk breezes from E to E got on and off
rigging here and off stays dyed sails &c
Isaac Holt off duty

570 Saturday February 26 1848

Came with fine weather and light
breezes from N E warped ship round to clear
Cables got a boat load of wood put Hole painted
the Lashed boat & the Lashed watches Liberty
expired this morning they got off after dark
except Charles Hanning James E Gilles John Munn
and Henry Rodenburg Middle and last part
wind and weather in continuance

571 Sunday February 27 1848

Came with fine weather and
brisk breezes from E to E the 4 men about still
Middle and last part wind and weather
in continuance

571 Monday February 28 1848

Came with fine weather and light
breezes from E to E painted the spare boat got off
a raft of water and two loads of wood and stored
them away got John Munn from the Messian at 10 am
and Charles Hanning and Henry Rodenburg from
the Eliza at 6 P M Cooper still absent Holt off
duty still Middle and last part wind and weather
in continuance

572 Tuesday February 29 1848

Came with fine weather and light
breezes from E to E got three boat loads off wood cut and
stored it got a ton of yards and some sand put
up the Lashed main beginning thereof up the main
and set up Backstays coil of Holt off duty Cooper
still absent Middle and last part wind and weather
in continuance

573 Wednesday March 1 1848

Came with fine weather and
light breezes from E to E got 6 or 8 of potatoes
the Cooper in the Callabore got a Cooper from
the Messian to fit a raft the Lashed watch on
duty the third Mate died Cooper of the John A
Bolt got drowned to day in attempting to creep
the reef shaly in the midst of life we are in
the midst of death those three men left their
ship this morning in good weather and spirits to
go to them out of 6 I perished in the way so we
see the frailty of life death is nearest on shore when
least expecting of death all mortals are shorn of life
we are uncertain when the summons comes we must be
prepared or unprepared as death finds us so he takes us
Middle and last part wind and weather in continuance

574 Thursday March 2 1848

Came with fine weather and
light breezes from E to E the Lashed watch on duty
fitted the last the Cooper came on board at 6 P M
