

Boque Cherokee in the Japan Sea Whaling
 continued at 10 saw another ring headed to E by the wind cut
 when hauled up the line of the Brail
 623 Wednesday April 19 1848

Cont^d with cloudy squally weather with
 rain and fresh breezes from S E headed to S W at noon
 hauled more top sail and two reefed the main to the middle

Middle part fresh breezes and cloudy at
 2 a m since hauled for S E to N W saw to star
 set two reef top sails

Last part cloudy with fresh breezes from
 N W made sail as required broke out in the after sail
 and began to steam down began to hail saw a sail and
 daylight Island dist 25 or 30 miles saw 3 or 4 right
 whales round then boats the started boat started again

Latitude by obs 36° 48' N

624 Thursday April 20 1848

Cont^d with fine but cloudy weather
 and light breezes from N W saw a sail and daylight Island
 being N of W sailed ahead steered down saw a right
 whale covered of boats the started boat started and
 steamed

Middle part cloudy and light air with fog
 sailing and steaming down

Last part fine but cloudy weather and
 light breezes from S W steered to S E sailing and dipping low
 saw 5 sail & walkers saw daylight Island the ship between
 them the main in sight

Latitude by obs 37° 17' North

Longitude by Chron^o

625 Friday April 21 1848

Cont^d with fine weather and light
 breezes from S W steered to S E sailing and dipping
 low saw the two Islands and the main 4 sail and
 a right whale round then boats to no purpose
 two reefed at 7 P M

Middle part cloudy with fresh breezes from S E
 to N W steered by the wind each way

Last part light breezes from N W saw a sail
 hauled made sail as required
 Latitude by obs 37° 00' North
 Longitude by Chron^o 151° 00' E

626 Saturday April 22 1848

Cont^d with fine weather and light air from
 4 sail and three right whales covered then boats fired
 6 or 8 right whales covered the other but all to no purpose
 took in sail the Lbs started at one sailed

Middle part cloudy with light breezes from
 S E steered S W sailing

Last part fine but cloudy with light
 breezes from S E steered to S W saw 4 sail spoke ship
 Mechanic Latham Newport 17 months ago from she was
 in Co with the ship of R B Caring her first whale
 saw daylight Island sailed
 Latitude by obs 37° 15' North

627 Sunday April 23 1848

Cont^d with fine but cloudy weather and
 light breezes from S E saw 5 sail spoke and one right whale
 covered then boats to no purpose saw two sail covered
 down at 7 P M

Middle part fine weather and no wind
 Last part fine weather and light breezes from
 the S steered to E steered down in the after sail saw two sail
 and two right whales covered the Lard boat to no purpose
 Latitude by obs 37° 15' North

Longitude by Chron^o 151° 00' E

628 Monday April 24 1848

Cont^d with fine weather and small breezes
 from S E steered to E saw two sail and daylight Island at 4 P M
 2 m spoke ship Patriot Mearns Bremm 30th 14th 00
 saw a fisher finished steaming down

Middle part cloudy weather and light
 breezes from S E steered to E by the wind at daylight saw two sail
 Last part cloudy weather and light breezes from
 S E steered to the wind each way saw the Patriot in chase of a sail
