for C to A^d steered so saw one right whale galloped
him with the ship did not lower sailing

Latitude by obs 38.08 North

636 Tuesday May 2 1848

Cont^d with fine weather and light breezes

for C steered so saw one right whale

Middle part fine weather and light breezes

Last part fine weather and light breezes for S

steered to N. saw sailing saw a couple saw one right
whale lowered the Larboard boat to no purpose saw the ship

Latitude by obs 38.06 North

Longitude from Chron^o 151.54 E

637 Wednesday May 3 1848

Cont^d with fine weather and light breezes

for S saw a right whale lowered S boat the Larboard

boat struck & the S^d killed him with the end the Larboard

boat got stuck and capsize in fastening the Larboard boat

got a broken gunwale in taking the gun off the boat

the whale ran under the boat he turned up and struck

he took the waist boat him a lance and bar and

a flat of him from the other boat & took in sail at night

Middle part fine weather and light breezes

Last part fine weather and small breezes

saw plenty of whales lowered both quarters boats the S^d

dated at our destination to another and drewed

came on board they it again the S^d dated at

another the S^d fastened to one and took him the

Jacob S. Cleveland Master

continued the ship at noon holed put a boat in the waist craning

638 Thursday May 4 1848 S^d started at one

Cont^d with fine weather and

light breezes cut the whole saw him holed the Larboard
boat went off them to no purpose

Middle part fine weather and light breezes

holed and cleared the head

Last part fine weather and light breezes

for S finished the old blubber stowed down in the other hole

lowered two boats one and then boats to no purpose saw a

number of whales and a sail a black

639 Friday May 5 1848

Cont^d with fine weather and light

breezes for S saw whales two saw two black & a hump

back lowered the Larboard boat and then boats over the

starboard boat struck and killed a whale took him to

the ship at 10 P.M.

Middle part foggy & calm

Last part foggy and calm cut the whale

and cleared up saw a sail

640 Saturday May 6 1848

Cont^d with foggy weather and calm.

stowed down in the other hole saw a sail began to hoist

at 8 P.M.

Middle part cloudy with light breezes

Last part foggy weather and small breezes

caught a seal stowed down lower & scraped some flatter down

holed saw a sail and saw many at whales lowered three

boats the waist boat got one

Latitude by obs 38.05 N

Longitude from Chron^o 151.55 E

641 Sunday May 7 1848

Cont^d with foggy weather and small

breezes for S cut the whale saw a sail

Middle part cloudy squally with rain

and heavy gale from N. holed S^d & took in sail & came

cleared the M. top sail at midnight could see
