Last part fine weather and light breezes
saw & sail two sailing made sail and started the
works at 8 a m saw whales at noon

Latitude by obs $38^{\circ} 49'$ North

Longitude by Chron $151^{\circ} 54'$ E

646 Monday May 8 1848

Count with fine weather and light breezes
for the m saw three sail covered the L & M boats for
a sight whole the main boat started two and at
him did not fasten

Middle part fine weather and light breezes

Last part fine weather and small breeze

Sailed set up shrouks mended main boat saw two sail
sailing saw whales covered them boats to no purpose
spoke the ship visited states of Nantucket with 5 whales

648 Tuesday May 9 1848

Count with fine weather and light breezes

Sailed and set up shrouks saw two sail and whales but
the masted boat saw and three boats on to no purpose

Middle part fine weather and light breezes

Last part fine but cloudy weather and light

breezes for & saw lots of whales covered them boats the L & M
started the m & got one took him to the ship at 11 a m
sailed & set up shrouks Nicholas off duty saw a sail took in sail
Latitude by obs $39^{\circ} 08'$ North

Longitude by Chron $151^{\circ} 57'$ E

644 Wednesday May 10 1848

Count with cloudy weather and light breeze
for & a deep swell cut the whale gave him a sail
sailed set up shrouks &c

Middle part cloudy with light breezes

Last part foggy with light breezes sailed

Thursday and set up shrouks saw one sight whales

645 Friday May 11 1848

Count with cloudy foggy weather
and light breezes started off the after hole put on
on the oil

Middle part cloudy and foggy with
light breezes for & m

Last part cloudy with fresh breezes
for & m & sailed and started down in the fore hole
saw a sail Nicholas and Isaac Holt off duty
Latitude by obs $39^{\circ} 24'$ North

Longitude by Chron $151^{\circ} 28'$ E

646 Friday May 12 1848

Count with cloudy weather and a fresh
gale for & m handed one course and close reefed the
m top sail at 12 m finished heeling the old blubber
and cooled down stored down and off the line stall

Middle part cloudy with light breezes
for & m by each way

Last part cloudy with light breezes

Set three reef top sails scraped bone coopered oil mended
boat saw finbacks and two sight whales covered them
boats one and three boats once to no purpose two m off duty

647 Saturday May 13 1848

Count with cloudy weather and fresh breezes

for & m saw a finback finished scraping bone coopering oil &c

Middle part cloudy with fresh breezes for & m

Last part cloudy and foggy and fresh

breezes for & m saw plenty of whales all land m began
to heave saw a sail covered them boats the L & M
boat struck one got him spouting blood cut to five feet
the ship took him and saw the other boats on board
two m off duty

Latitude by obs $39^{\circ} 10'$ North

Longitude by Chron $151^{\circ} 57'$ E

648 Sunday May 14 1848

Count with cloudy foggy weather and
fresh breezes for & m & sailed saw whales covered
two boats to no purpose took in sail at 52 m rough
sailed

Middle part cloudy foggy and light
breezes for & m & headed to m & m of the same sailing
