and some rain. A.M. light sailing
winds the watch at various duties

Remarks On Friday Jan 20th
P.M. light breeze from S. stirring by the
wind, weather cloudy and squalls hanging
around, making sent attending to other
duties. at 4 h. cleared up, and was met
at 3 h. saw Blackfish lower three
boats and saw them W chased did not see
any. Midnight light breeze and calm
A.M. 6 h. saw Blackfish again lower three
boats, and chased them to the windward about
5 miles, got aboard the ship 1. A.M. hands
employed.

Remarks On Saturday Jan 21st
P.M. light breeze from S heading M.
setting up flying jib & jib guys attending
to other duties at 4 h. cleared up and washed
off. Midnight light breeze and
some rain. A.M. having a
light breeze from S the watch employed
at making sunt and attending to
various other duties.
At 7 h. got an Spt of 3'
A none

Remarks On Sunday Jan 22nd

P.M. light breeze from S.S.W heading
M.S.W. the weather has the appearance
of being foggy and raining large heavy
clouds hanging around. Watch sent
duty being washing paint work at 4 h.
sailed the watch and washed off the decks
Midnight had a steady breeze all night
A.M. having a gentle breeze from S.S.W
heading S.W. nothing transpired
worthy of notice.

Lat 37 miles N Long 21.17' W

Remarks On Monday Jan 23rd
P.M. having gentle breeze from S.E. suppose
they are the tracks. Ship heading S.W.
the weather is remarkably pleasant and very
smooth no duty going only what is necessary
working ship &c. Midnight had light
breeze though the night. A.M.
light breeze at 1, got the tacked over
fore hole and broke out, looking for cordage
at fore weather looks squally, started off for
hole couldn't find the cordage.
