Remarks On Tuesday Jan 22nd 1860
P.M. got the tackle up over the
after hbs breaking out for cordage
putted coffee at 4h, finished. Stearns
swept the deck. Ship heading S.W.
with moderate trade.

A.M. pleasant weather and clear
the watch to work making sund
and attending to other duties at
4h, cleared up and washed off. 2h.
saw a bc

Lat 02.17 S Long 24.23

Remarks On Wednesday Jan 23rd
P.M. Moderate trading heading S.W.
at 2, saw a bunch of bc quarter
steered for it till nearly 4 saw nothing
more of it buffed to the wind again
cleared up and washed off. Midnight
wind and weather the same.
A.M. ship going along with all sail set
at 6 got the tackle up took main hold and
broke out for water at 10h, stowed down
employed remainder of time to work
drawing and knotting yarns.

Lat 04.06 S Long 26.01 W

Remarks On Thursday Jan 24th
P.M. light pleasant weather ship
heading S.W. the watch employed
drawing and knotting yarns at 4
cleared up and washed off. Midnight
a fresh breeze all night at 10 checked
in the yards steering a course S.W.
A.M. at 6 turn the way hands got some
hot junk for making spinnage at 7
got breakfast. Starboard watch on deck drawing
and knotting yarns.

Remarks On Friday Jan 25th
P.M. pleasant weather with fresh trade
steering a course S.W. Starboard watch on
deck drawing & knotting yarns. At 3 brass
up the yards. 4 called the watch and
washed off. Midnight strong trade
took in fore topgallant and set at again
A.M. pleasant weather with fresh trade
port watch on deck drawing & knotting
yarns broke out for flour. "to end"

Lat 08.41 S Long 29.27

Remarks On Saturday Jan 26th
P.M. Strong trade steering a course
S.W. Starboard watch on deck knotting
and balling up yarns. 4h. cleared
up and washed off. Midnight strong
trade. A.M. Starboard watch on
deck drawing & knotting yarns and
attending to other duties at 1 saw a
sail off the beam steering S.W.

Lat 11.23 S Long 31.28 W

Remarks On Sunday Jan 27th
P.M. pleasant weather with a steady
breeze steering S.W. by N. Port watch
on deck cleaning ship and attending
to various other duties at 1 saw a
ship off weather beam steering S.W.
at 2 call the watch and washed off
Midnight nearly the same. A.M. pleasant
weather and warm at 4h saw a
ship off the quarter.
