

Remarks On Thursday Feb 16th 1860
 P.M. having a strong wind from E.
 heading S. steering by the wind. Starboard
 watch on deck employed at making
 sennet. 4th washed up the deck and
 washed off. At 11th we got up in sail
 for the first time for whaling ground.
 blowing strong all night. at daylight
 turned the reef out of the main topsail
 and had a few rain squalls. 4th Starboard
 watch on deck employed at making sennet
 steering S. Lat 37.42 Longitude 51.25 West

Remarks On Friday Feb 17th
 P.M. having a moderate wind from
 E. steering by course S. 12 N. Port watch
 on deck employed at making
 sennet. 3rd h. set the maintop sail
 4th washed off. at 11th we set shorten
 sail and hove to the wind on the
 port tack. strong wind through the
 night. A.M. 10 strong wind from
 N. N. E. at the mainsail and out to go
 Port watch on deck.
 Lat 37.30 South Longitude 51.25 West

Remarks On Saturday Feb 18th
 P.M. strong wind from N. N. E. steering
 a course S. S. W. Starboard watch on deck
 employed. 4th washed off. 3rd got supper
 midnight strong wind. A.M.
 thick cloudy weather and squalls
 with some rain. at 10th doubled
 reef the fore & main topsail wind
 from N. W.
 Lat 11.28 S. Longitude 51.13 West

Remarks On Sunday Feb 19th
 P.M. strong wind & squalls from N. W.
 steering a course S. S. W. at 3rd h. wind from S. W. ship closed
 to the wind. Port watch on deck
 washing the paint work. 8th powder
 and balling wind. wind ship headed
 S. W. Midnight the wind & weather the same
 A.M. Port watch on deck, show and cool
 made some sail 1st h. saw a sail.
 Lat 47.42 Longitude 51.27 West

Remarks On Monday Feb 20th
 P.M. clear and cool wind from N. N. E.
 at 3rd h. steering a course S. S. W. and
 set the fore & main topsail the wind
 moderate and balling at 10th h.
 braced around on the starboard tack
 at daylight a gentle breeze from N.
 S. W. heading S. S. W. this morning
 broke out the fore hold got up floor
 of bread and put it down in the sub-
 room and the fore put the after hold for to
 go in the fore hold. Lat 42.12 South Longitude 51.12 West

Remarks On Tuesday Feb 21st
 P.M. clear and pleasant with a
 gentle wind from N. Port watch on
 deck employed at stowing meat. 3rd h.
 fore hold at 3rd h. had a squall from
 S. W. with some rain. got in the
 light sails and double reefed the tops.
 hauled the mainsail and loosed it again.
 Midnight strong wind. A.M.
 turned one reef out of the topsail. at
 9th h. reefed the fore topsail.
 Lat 49.36 Longitude 49.30 West
