

Remarks On Tuesday Feb 28th
 P.M. Hailing a gentle breeze from N.W. weather clear and pleasant and the water very smooth at 2h. got a gyral. The Edgeland steered at 3h. steering S.W. by W. fine breeze all night. A.M. at 10h. saw land on E. of the Falkland Islands bearing N.W. by N. 13 miles distant. Blowing strong from N.W. at 12h. double reefed the topsails. Saw great quantity of kelp and Penguin
 Lat 51° 30' South Long 57° 40' West

Remarks On Wednesday Feb 29th
 P.M. Blowing a moderate gale from N.W. steering S.W. by E. 1h. reefed the main topsail, 2h. closed reefed the fore & main topsail and furled the mizzen staying S.W. by N. 4h. more moderate steering S.W. by E. Had a variety through the night change of winds &c at 6h. had a steady wind from N.W. heading S. 5h. furled the mizzen and set the light sails ship heading S.W. by N. 9h. steering at course S.W.
 Lat 52° 15' South Long 58° 30' West

Remarks On Thursday March 1st
 P.M. Clear and pleasant weather with a gentle wind from N.W. steering at course S.W. by E. Ship under all sail at 3h. course S.W. by E. 4h. hauled ship. 5h. strong breeze and a heavy swell from N.W. double reefed the topsails steering S.W. by E. 6h. hauled the mizzen got strong winds A.M. rain and squall. 6h. turned out the mizzen. 8h. set main topgallant sail flying jib & mizzen. Ship back at night
 Lat 52° 30' South Long 59° 20' West

Remarks On Friday March 2nd
 P.M. A moderate wind from N.W. steering S.W. by E. compass 2 points var E. 2h. hauled the mizzen and brought at 3h. a top in the topgallant sail & flying jib double reefed the topsails. Ship heading S.W. by N. at 4h. closed reefed the topsails furled the mainsail. 5h. light air and calms. saw a ship off weather quarter steering N.E.
 Lat 53° 21' South Long 61° 21' West

Remarks On Saturday March 3rd
 P.M. S.E. light breeze & squalls at 2h. veered ship headed N.W. by E. by compass 2 points var E. 3h. light wind from E. I struck to a fresh breeze steering N.W. by W. true course. a good breeze through the night. A.M. pleasant weather cool & clear. 8h. saw a clipper ship steering S.E. having a fresh from S.E. ship under all sail good weather for Cape Horn
 Lat 54° 00' South Long 64° 40' West

Remarks On Sunday March 4th
 P.M. Having a fresh breeze from S.E. steering N.W. by W. true course. weather good at 3h. steering S.W. by W. true course 4h. pump ship. A gentle east wind all night. A.M. wind and weather about the same. At 1h. hauled the mizzen. At 2h. the course was steering S.W. by E. S.W. by N. at 3h. saw a ship off port quarter
