 on deck employed on the rigging, at 4^h.
 cleared up & washed off at sunset with
 the wind all night. A.M. Starboard watch on deck
 employed on the main rigging capping
 & seaming it, attending to various other
 duties.

Remarks On Sunday April 29th
 P.M. A moderate wind from S.
 with pleasant weather. - Ship heading
 S.W. by W. by the wind. Port watch on
 deck employed on the fore & main rigging
 capping & seaming it, & part washing the
 paint work &c. Midnight by the wind
 at daylight, raised quite an excitement
 saw a whale ahead about five times all
 hands much alarmed. Turned out to be
 blackfish, steering W.N.W.
 Lat 3.25 South Long 17.35 West

Remarks On Monday April 30th
 P.M. Moderate weather, steering N.W.
 saw from 1000 yds. Starboard watch on
 deck, at 3^h, got a small observation
 having excellent weather. At sunset left
 to the wind, - Midnight, steering S.W. by W.
 A.M. 6^h, steering S.W. by W. having
 good weather, - Starboard watch on deck
 employed send up the mizzen stay &
 set it up, at 7^h, saw a small white whale
 & going off starboard bow steered for it & found
 it to be a fisher. Lat 4.04 Long 18.04 West

Remarks On Tuesday May 1st
 P.M. Having a gentle wind from S.
 steering S.W. by W. Port watch on deck
 employed at rasting fore rigging, & attending
 to various other duties, 7^h, cleared up
 & washed off at sunset with the high
 squalls & left to the wind. Midnight
 laying out the main topmast deck
 A.M. 5^h, brace forward & steered S.
 Port watch on deck employed at rasting
 fore rigging, - at 12^h, saw a small white whale
 off port bow steering S.W. Lat 3.37 Long 18.57 West

Remarks On Wednesday May 2nd
 P.M. Moderate weather steering S.W. &
 Starboard watch on deck employed at rasting
 main rigging, & attending to other duties
 at 2^h, steering S.W. washed off at sunset
 due to the wind with main topmast
 deck. Midnight steered ship heading
 S.W. A.M. fine weather for whaling. -
 Starboard watch on deck employed on the
 main rigging, - at 9 o'clock saw sports of starboard
 bow steered for them found them to be Finbacks
 Lat 3.52 South Long 19.30 West

Remarks On Thursday May 3rd
 P.M. Moderate weather steering S.W.
 Port watch on deck employed at rasting
 fore rigging & attending to other duties
 at 4^h, cleared up & washed off
 Midnight steering full & by. A.M.
 6^h, steering S.W. Port watch on deck
 employed on the fore & fore topmast
 rigging at 11^h saw a small white whale
 ahead for it & found it to be Finbacks
 Lat 3.11 South Long 19.39 West
