 topsail aback. A.M. brace forward steering
 by the wind heading S. Starboard watch on deck
 employed at rarting main topmast rigging

 P.M. Moderate weather & pleasant
 at 12 M. wore ship & steering S. by W.
 Port watch on deck employed at rarting
 fore topmast rigging, - at 12.30 caught a
 Cowfish playing around the bow at sun-
 set luff to the wind with the main
 topsail aback. Midnight pleasant laying
 with the m. topsail aback. A.M. got the tabled
 up over after hold got out tubs & Coffish & then
 down the main hold & got out flour & Bread
 & employed at rarting m. topmast rigging
 Lat 4.04 South Long 104.39 West

Remarks On Sunday May 6th
 P.M. gentle winds & pleasant weather steering
 N. by W. Starboard watch on deck employed at
 rarting m. topmast rigging & attending to
 various other duties cleaning ship &c. at 4th
 wore ship & steered full & by. Midnight
 laying with the main topsail aback. A.M.
 brace forward & steered S. by W. with a gentle wind
 at 1st steering S.W. Starboard watch on deck
 on deck.
 Lat 4.27 South Long 104.54 West

Remarks On board Monday May 7th 1860
 P.M. Barring beautiful weather with gentle
 breeze just right for whaling but no whale
 steering this afternoon S.W. by S. Port watch on
 deck at 4th saw a white whale off Port bow
 at sun set luff to the wind. Midnight
 laying with the main topsail aback. A.M.
 wore ship steered S. by W. with a nice
 breeze, - Port watch on deck employed on the
 fore rigging spare hands making sinnet
 Lat 4.41 South Long 106.31 West

Remarks on board Tuesday May 8th
 P.M. Moderate weather as usual with com-
 ing clouds & a gentle wind, - steering S. by W.
 Starboard watch on deck employed on the trupper
 rigging & attending to other duties. Midnight wore
 ship, - A.M. steering S.W. by S. catch in the gale
 1st starboard watch on deck employed at making
 sinnet, - having nice weather for "off shore"
 but no "Whales" & I don't look as if there is any on
 the ground as may come across on by & by.
 Lat 4.56 South Long 107.41 West

Remarks on board Wednesday May 9th
 P.M. Fine weather & gentle winds, at 12 M.
 wore ship & steered S. by W. Port watch on
 deck employed at up flying jib stay &c.
 at sun set hauled up the courses and luff
 to the wind, heading S. by S. steering full &
 by. Midnight wore ship. A.M. at 1st S.
 steering S. by W. 1 o'clock port watch on deck
 employed on the fore topmast backstay, at 12 M.
 wore ship and steered S. by W.
 Lat 5.26 South Long 108.10 West
