 P.M. The weather fresh & cloudy with
 some rain squalls, having a gentle wind
 steering S.W. by Comp. Starboard watch on
 deck employed at carrying the main rigging
 at 4h, cleared up & gashed off. Sprung
 steering S.W. by S. with a fresh breeze
 S.W. by S. Starboard watch on deck employed
 at carrying mizzen rigging. "We've had nice
 weather today, but very dry, as you can see
 our ground for the night, I hope we may see
 something. Lat 12° 26' South Long 116° 21' West

Remarks on board Thursday May 17th.
 P.M. Having fine weather enough for
 anything, all at anchor is to see if the
 there is any in the Pacific Ocean, steering
 S.W. by S. for the line. Port watch on deck employ
 I run and took in the light sails
 at 4h, took up the courses, steering S.W. by S.
 Midnight at 12 o'clock. S.W. at daylight
 made sail, steering S.W. by S. Port watch
 on deck, at 12 o'clock, were ship steering
 S.W.
 Lat 12° 30' South Long 117° 22' West

Remarks on board Friday May 18th.
 P.M. Commenced with moderate winds
 & pleasant weather, steering S.W. by
 Comp. Starboard watch on deck
 attending to ship's duty. The ship is all
 fixed & everything all right. At sunset took in the
 light sails, at midnight took in the wind on
 Port tack. S.W. made sail at daylight & steered
 S.W. Starboard watch on deck.
 Lat 12° 36' South Long 118° 32' West

 P.M. Gentle trades, & pleasant weather
 steering S.W. at 12 o'clock ship steered
 S.W. by Comp. Port watch on deck employed
 at picking up the gear, saw a jumper
 from aloft. at 1h washed off, with the help
 of the crew. Midnight at 12 o'clock took in
 the wind, with the courses at 4h. S.W.

 watch on deck, at 1h, saw a breach
 & pointed off starboard bow run, for it saw
 nothing more suppose to be jumpers.

 daylight steering S.W. by Comp.
 fair & pleasant. pleasant & warm
 Starboard watch on deck.
 Lat 12° 04' South Long 119° 40' West

Remarks on board Monday May 21st.
 P.M. Pleasant weather & moderate
 winds, steering S.W. Port watch on
 deck, at 1h, saw a sail ahead
 at 4h, spoke her, Bath Bottombus of Port
 "Cape Luce" & mounted out with 140 lbs of
 sperm oil. Cape went aboard, the mate
 came aboard of us, the boat came aboard.
 were ship & layed with the main topsail aback
 through the night. S.W. 5h, steering S.W. at
 1h, were ship steering S.W. by S. at 12 o'clock, saw a
 sail 1h, pointed off with the bow. Lat 12° 53' South Long 119° 42'
