Remarks on board Wednesday June 27th
 P.M. Fresh trades, ship heading E
 by S. by the wind. Starboard watch on deck
 broke out for "Bread" & filled two more
 cask with salt water, put them forward
 it's made a good difference the last 23 hours
 in the ship's sailing. Midnight pleasant
 & moonlight, steering by the wind. P.M.
 fair weather & smooth sea. Starboard
 watch on deck, employed at rigging a
 main topmast stay, & attending the others during
 Lat 13° 35' South Long 115° 52' West

Remarks on board Thursday June 28th
 P.M. Commences with pleasant & moderate
 trades, ship full & by all sail out heading
 S. Port watch on deck busy on the main
 topmast stay, at 4^h set it up & bent
 the sail, ran inner jib. Midnight
 full & by S. A.M. bent the fore topmast
 stay, at 1^h Port watch on deck repairing
 an old stay, to put in the in
 place of the one on it bent yesterday, at
 11^h finished it & bent it.
 Lat 10° 28' South Long 116° 03' West

Remarks on board Friday June 29th
 P.M. Having beautiful weather a
 good wind & smooth sea. Steaming
 full & by heading S.E. Starboard
 watch on deck employed at repairing
 the "Spanker", sent up a "Gee Migger"
 in the fore. Strong winds through the
 night took in the light sails in the Mizzen
 watch. At 3^h A.M. set the main topmast sail
 1^h Starboard watch on deck, sent down
 the foresail to repair.
 Lat 12° 33' South Long 116° 15' West

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Remarks on Saturday June 30th
 P.M. Fresh trades, ship heading S
 by E. by the wind. Port watch on deck
 at work on the foresail. At 2^h finished
 it & bent it, swept the deck, at 4^h washed
 off. Midnight strong winds from E
 P.M. ship heading S.E. & S.E. by S. A.M.
 first this morning got the tackel up
 over the after hold & broke old mast, and
 put it down in the fore hold, put sails
 down in the place of the mast. 1^h & 11^h
 squally took in the top gal sail & flying jib
 Lat 7° 45' South Long 115° 55'

Remarks on Sunday July 1st
 P.M. Moderate wind from E. by S.
 ship heading S.E. by S. Starboard watch
 on deck employed at breaking fore
 hold, started a cask of water & hoisted
 out "Gee" to make room for meat
 at 4^h finished stowing down & raised
 off, set the top gal sail & flying jib
 Midnight a fresh wind. P.M. 5^h
 squally with some rain. 4^h Starboard watch
 on deck took in the top gal sail & flying jib at
 9^h strong squalls double reef the fore top sail on
 in the top sail. Lat 16° 31' South Long 115° 36'

Remarks on Monday July 2nd
 P.M. Strong winds from E. by S. & a
 rugged sea, steering full & by heading
 S.E. Port watch on deck at 1^h put on
 reef in the Mizzen top sail & turned on
 out of the fore top sail. At 4^h saw sports
 astern, wore ship & steered for them found
 them to be hinds, wore ahead full & by
 Midnight steering full & by S.M. Port
 watch on deck at 1^h put on reef in
 the fore top sail.
 Lat 18° 09' South Long 115° 10'
