Ship heading S.W. by the wind. Starboard
watch on deck employed at getting out
water, & filling with salt water. At
1^h got out 3 firkins of Butter from
against hold. - "While well & on deck"
Wind blowing through the night heading
from S to N.E. A.M. weather clear
& squally. At 9^h saw a sail ahead
steering N.W.

Remarks on Monday July 14th
P.M. Having a fresh wind S.W. &
Ship heading S.W. weather cloudy &
squally. Port watch on deck. Midnight
blowing winds. A.M. 6^h tacked ship
headed N.W. 7^h Port watch on deck
at 9^h tacked ship headed S.W. by the
wind. Weather cool & cloudy, about
all we see is a Hinback & a Sulphur
Bottom occasionally, everything works against
us, we are trying to get to the Archer Ground
but we are making a long passage of it unfavorable
winds & light at night.

Remarks on Tuesday July 15th
P.M. Light winds from S.W. & cloudy
weather. Ship heading S.W. Starboard
watch on deck. - prospects look dubious at
getting to the Archer Ground. - M. Peing on deck
attending to duty. at 6^h wore ship headed
N.W. Midnight blowing winds.
A.M. Starboard watch on deck attending to
ship's duty. weather cool & cloudy & light
winds.
Lat 21.43 South Long 102.37

Remarks on Wednesday July 18th
P.M. Having light baffling winds from
S.W. heading S.W. & N.W. by the
wind. weather cool & cloudy. Port watch
on deck employed at drawing yarn
for seining stuff. Midnight steering
full & by variable winds. A.M.
Port watch on deck, at 7^h saw a
Hinback spouting & breaching. watch
employed at making seining stuff
at 4^h finished & sweep the deck
Lat nun - Long nun

Remarks on Thursday July 19th
P.M. Cloudy weather & baffling winds
from S.W. steering by the wind
heading S.W. & N.W. Starboard watch
on deck employed at making seining
stuff. Midnight strong winds &
squally. A.M. strong winds with thick
cloudy weather. 7^h Starboard watch on
deck, sent down the main topsail, sent
up another in its place. the watch
employed at repairing the main topsail
at 11 hours saw a Hinback.
Lat 19 Long 101.22

Remarks on Friday July 20th
P.M. Strong winds from S.W. & S.E.
heading S.W. by the wind. Port
watch on deck to work on the main
topsail. At 3^h squally picked up
& stowed away & took in the fling-
jib - at 9^h strong squalls with rain
put on reef in the topsails, a fresh
stead wind till 5 P.M. & then some squally
7^h Port watch on deck, at 8^h at work on
the main topsail at 12 finished it.
