 jib. 2^h. 1^h. got on reef in the
 fore topsail.

Remarks on Sunday July 22nd
 P.M. got ruggled & squally. - 2^h. M. ruggled
 and ruggled and the main topgal sail &
 flying jib, ship heading N.E. by the wind.
 1^h. Starboard watch on deck cleaning ship at
 1^h. washed the deck. Midnight strong
 wind & squalls at 2^h. took in main
 topgalant-sail & flying jib. 4^h. Starboard watch
 on deck having strong squalls, put on
 reef in the main topsail. 11^h. ship headed
 S.E.

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Remarks on Tuesday July 24th
 P.M. Commenced with a strong steady
 wind from E. by N. heading S.E. by S.
 by the wind. - 1^h. put on reef in
 the main topsail. 3^h. quite moderate
 saw many birds, turned the reef out
 of the main topsail & set flying jib main
 to gal sail. 11^h. flying winds through the night
 at 1^h. took in ship headed S.E. at 4^h. took
 ship. 5^h. squally & rainy 1^h. Starboard watch on
 deck fair weather.

Remarks on Wednesday July 25th
 P.M. Pleasant weather, glass horizon and
 distant good seeing. Having a nice
 steady wind from E. by N. ship heading
 S.E. by the wind. Starboard watch on
 deck, at 3^h. got a "Lunar". Midnight
 light air and calm through the night
 P.M. calm. 1^h. Starboard watch on deck, got
 "Sugar" from the forward hold. - perfectly calm
 all of the latter part

 P.M. Having light breeze from the
 Western, steering a course E. by S. comp.
 Starboard watch on deck, got out "Sugar"
 from fore hold. 2^h. got a "Lunar" Long 16.52
 Midnight had a nice steady wind from
 S.E. ship heading E. by N. M.
 clear & pleasant wind. Topping
 Starboard watch on deck attending
 at ship's duty.
