Remarks on Monday Nov 5th

P.M. Fresh trade, heading off shore
Species of weather beam. Saw a number
large Blackfish, the fleet to the windward
Midnight were still headed inshore
A.M. This morning at daylight in sight
of the fleet heading into sea bed. Starboard
watch on deck breaking out water hold for
Sugar, & hoisted up at east of Butte. P.M.
Port watch on deck employed at iron hoops
the Butte, P.M. "Rocondudo" bearing N.W. 1/2
10 miles dist

Remarks on Tuesday Nov 6th

P.M. Steering along shore to the northern with
moderate trade. Port watch on deck attended
at Ship's duty. At 1 P.M. Capt. went ashore fishing
in the main time Ship off & on, got alongside
at 4 P.M. with nice mess. At 10 P.M. at daylight
Rocondudo & Butte, 1 number of small fish
saw the Butte's Blackfish, bearing
a strong weather current just about
mid way own. At 2 P.M. "Rocondudo" to the bearing
of us 3/4 mile off.

Remarks on Wednesday Nov 7th

P.M. Having gentle trade, ship on
the off shore watch. Port watch on deck atten
at Ship's duty. 3 sails off the bow. At 4 P.M.
tackles hauled up the mainmast for a
sail with 2 Bar. At 5 P.M. Capt. Hamilton com-
manded from the deck of N.S. exchange boat
enews &c. Midnight on the inshore track
with the courses up. A.M. At daylight much
all sail. 4 P.M. Port watch on deck. P.M. lowered
one boat for Blackfish could not get on.
Rocondudo bearing N.W. 1/2 10 miles dist

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Remarks on Thursday Nov 8th

P.M. Commenced with moderate trade
Ship heading for North head, saw many
porfish & Blackfish going quick to windward. Watch
on deck attending at Ship's duty, most
of the fleet insight. At 5 P.M. tacked headed off
shore. Midnight tacked inshore. A.M.
P.M. tacked off shore, at daylight fleet insight
to windward. P.M. Starboard watch on deck
employed at making sinned & other
duties, having a strong current setting
to windward. "Rocondudo" off to beam.

Remarks on Friday Nov 9th

P.M. Having gentle trade, & fine
weather, 1 P.M. tacked and steered off for
Ed. Carri, closed to stern. Port watch on deck
employed. At 4 P.M. Rocondudo bearing N.W.
1/2 mile dist. Midnight began to N.E. side
of Abernal, A.M. light breeze from E
heading off shore. P.M. Port watch on deck
employed at making sinned &c.
steering up. P.M. At 11 by the wind
passed to leeward of Rocondudo closed
two.
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Remarks on Saturday Nov 10th

P.M. Commenced with fresh trade, ship
by the wind heading to Western part of
the fleet insight again. Bark Pacific run
down off our bow & left to the wind.
At 3 P.M. tacked headed inshore, 2 sails in view
1/2 mile off, all night. This morning
Ship off shore & whole of the fleet insight
employed at breaking out water. P.M. Star
board watch on deck employed, steering to
the N. at 10 P.M. left to the wind on off
shore track.
