Remarks on Thursday March 27th
P.M. Commenced with moderate to fresh breeze and pleasant
sailing. At 10 P.M. Starboard watch on deck employed
saw Whimbucks. Moderate through the night. A.M.
1st Starboard watch on deck employed.

Remarks on Friday March 28th
P.M. Having light weather, steering S.W. by W. Port watch on deck
employed fitting blocks, & 1st luff to the wind, heaving
2nd Whimbucks. Moderate S.W. breeze. At daylight
commenced heaving for hold hoisted up ground tier
coopers at and refilled them with salted salt
water. 1st all hand on deck employed.

Remarks on Saturday March 29th
P.M. All hands on deck employed at breaking out
for hold. Ship heaving S. 2nd hold a squall with
rain. Midnight, few passing showers, &c. A.M. at
daylight turned to, Port watch on deck, 1st all hands on
deck employed 1st finished.

Remarks on Sunday March 30th
P.M. The first time Capt. had an occasion to
shoot a man "bought" about relieving the wind
I don't know the particulars. Port watch on deck employed
at washing the ship, steering S.W. Midnight
fresh wind. A.M. 1st Port watch on deck.

Remarks on Monday March 31st
P.M. Having fresh trades steering S.W. Starboard
watch on deck, 1st checked in the yards steering S.W.
Midnight & fresh wind steering S.W.
A.M. At daylight put the tackle up and for
hold commenced breaking out. 1st all hand on
deck, hoisted up the ground tier coopers at
stowed them again and filled them with salted salt
water.

Remarks on Tuesday March 31st
P.M. Commenced with strong breeze, steering
S.W. by W. All hand on deck employed at
stowing for hold. Midnight steering S.W.
A.M. employed at stowing for hold. 1st Port
watch on deck employed, 1st steering S.W. by W.
1st Port off duty sick. Lat 4-02 Long 131-34

Remarks on Wednesday March 31st
P.M. Having moderate trades, steering S.W. by W.
Starboard watch on deck employed, Midnight
fresh trades. A.M. at daylight commenced setting
up shooks for water. 1st Starboard watch on
deck employed. Lat 4-07 Long 130-56

Remarks on Thursday March 30th
P.M. Strong trades steering S.W. by W. Port watch
on deck employed at setting up shooks, "bark" on
deck. Midnight steering S.W. by W. A.M. employed
at setting up shooks, & 1st Port watch on deck, employed
Lat 4-12 Long 130-13

Remarks on Friday March 29th
P.M. Moderate trades, steering S.W. by W. Starboard
watch on deck employed at setting up shooks, & 1st
checked up and washed off. At 6th saw land
from aloft, ahead 30 miles dist. "Good's Rock" heaved
up the courses to and go under short sail. Midnight
laying off with 10 to 12 miles ahead. At daylight
blew forward and made sail and steered for the point
Dominaea, heading for "Roman Bay" 11th boat came aboard.
steered for "Alameda de la Cruz" Bay. At 1st drop the anchor
and a raft of cedar ashore &c.

Remarks on Saturday March 30th
P.M. Anchoring anchored watches through the night. At daylight
boats went for the raft of cedar, stowed it below. At 9th
brig herring ship arrived. A.M. sent in 2 raft of
cedar filled them and left them on the beach.
