

Mannam Bay

Remarks on Sunday March 31st

P.M. Light breeze and calm. This morning men on deck started fire for smoking ship. A.M. and half the crew ashore and attending prayers on board morning stand.

Remarks on Monday March 1st

P.M. Ship closed up, smoking ship, light wind and rain, sent port watch on deck at 3 o'clock. Port morning stand sail for on the water. A.M. down water come above J. Derby absent without leave.

Remarks on Tuesday April 2nd

P.M. Fair weather, having a light breeze blowing in from S.W. sent in a boat for water come off. 1 o'clock with six oars left the shore it being so rough, employed stowing & attending to their duties. A.M. Stowed off four hold 200 lbs of water, sent in another raft, and received 2 boat loads of coconuts.

Remarks on Wednesday April 3rd

12 o'clock midday on each side adrift from shore. The D boat picked up 7, log two. This morning employed at stowing, after breakfast went after raft of water and brought aboard. A.M. stowing water &c, received two boats load of coconuts, bananas & pumpkins, between the hours 9 & 10. A canon came under the boatstays with a mercian in it, it and shot three men, 2 Rogue Bay & John Portugal. The fired were deserted at water.

Remarks on Thursday April 4th

P.M. This morning light breeze and pleasant employ of numerous shots, 1 o'clock carried in a raft of coals and filled them took them aboard. Capt went ashore offered a reward for 1 o'clock & 1 mustel. A.M. caught one of the deserters, Rogue Bay brought him aboard and put him in on him, - natives looking for the other two.

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Remarks on Friday April 5th

P.M. Sent the starboard water ashore on liberty, employ on board turned up the starboard and waist boats to paint trading with the natives. Officers kept the watches. This morning took the rigors off of "Ray" he made such promises &c. Heard some flying news from the shore that they had caught the other two men "Allen & John".

Remarks on Saturday April 6th

P.M. Light winds with showers. Port starboard water ashore on liberty. The report last night that they had caught them men was false. This afternoon they caught them up in the bush and brought them down yet "Ship already for sea" with the exception of those men.

Remarks on Sunday April 7th

P.M. Breeze, unsteady winds. Capt went ashore, not anything going on. Ship waiting for those men. A.M. 1 o'clock received an order from Capt to send 3 bags of powder, 1 mustel & 1 piece of cloth to reward for them. 2 o'clock brought the men and the Mexican that took them. Natives are anxious for us to take him away, put all of them in for the present.

Remarks on Monday April 8th

P.M. Commenced with a fine breeze from the land, at 5 o'clock called all hands and got underway. Ray the two oars how to finish their story for "Mannam Bay" his arrival off the entrance. Capt went ashore after potatoes.

Remarks on Tuesday April 9th

P.M. Laying off & on off Mannam Bay, getting potatoes &c all aboard. Took the rigors off of "John". The Carpenter is gone deserted. This morning started Resolution Bay to get a Carpenter in place of the one deserted. P.M. Capt went ashore. Ship under the land. Down
