 P.M. Commenced with strong winds and rugged enough
 ship heading E. by the wind. 3 o'clock moderate with
 the light sails. Moderate through the night
 A.M. pleasant. At 1 o'clock, Starboard watch on
 deck employed. Lat 41° 23' North Long 108° 36'

Remarks on Thursday Aug 15th
 P.M. Quite moderate & smooth. Ship heading
 E. by the wind. Port watch on deck employed
 Midnight by the wind. A.M. squally & cloudy. Port
 watch on deck employed. Lat 41° 13' North Long 106° 52'

Remarks on Friday Aug 16th
 P.M. Commenced with thick squally weather ship heading
 E. by S by the wind. Starboard watch on deck. Midnight
 strong squalls. At 2 o'clock A.M. 1 o'clock quite
 fortunate not losing the boom. 1 o'clock Starboard watch on
 deck employed. Lat 41° 52' North Long 104° 41'

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Remarks on Saturday Aug 17th
 P.M. Strong winds and rugged, ship heading
 E. by S by the wind. Starboard watch on deck
 strong winds through the night. A.M. 1 o'clock, Port
 watch on deck sent down 4 sprit foot rope for repairs
 also f. stay. Lat. Port strong winds & squally.
 Lat 42° North Long 102° 55'

Remarks on Sunday Aug 18th
 P.M. Commenced with strong winds and squally rugged
 & cloudy. Ship heading E. by S by the wind. Starboard
 watch on deck employed at washing the wind, work and
 clearing up. 4 o'clock pumped at considerable rate. At 6, strong
 squalls doubtly raised the topsails, weather had a gloomy appearance
 but there was more rain than wind. At 8, turned out the reefs.
 A strong breeze remained of the night. A.M. quite moderate &
 pleasant at 1 o'clock, Starboard watch on deck. Had a school
 of Porpoises around. Lat 43° North Long 101° 02'

Remarks on Monday Aug 19th
 P.M. Sprinkled & smooth, ship by the wind at sail
 on, heading E. by S. Port watch on deck at 3 o'clock passed
 through a large tide rip. At 5, parted of fish guys, soon
 after caught a Porpoise. A moderate wind through
 the night. A.M. At daylight, thick & art. At 1, Port watch
 on deck employed at 1/2 fish guys & attending to
 other duties. Lat 44° North Long 99° 21'

Remarks on Tuesday Aug 20th
 P.M. Commenced with moderate winds, and then
 squally looking weather. Starboard watch on deck
 at 1 o'clock. At 2 o'clock got out 2 each of press.
 Ship heading E. by the wind. At 3, took in fore top
 gale sail, at 4, washed off. Midnight by the wind
 A.M. At daylight raining. 1 o'clock Starboard
 watch on deck employed at getting fish trash &
 black strops. Lat 44° North Long 97° 45'
