Remarks on Saturday Aug 24th

P.M. Moderate winds & wet thick weather. Ship heaving E. by S by the wind. Starboard watch on deck. At 4 o'clock caught 1st Porpoise. At 1 o'clock caught, landed 1st M. L. 1st Midnight moderate. W.M. at 2 o'clock landed marked E. & E. at 1, Starboard watch on deck employed.

P.M. Commences moderate with a P. head-fair and fair. heaving 2 P.M. by the wind. Port watch on deck. 1 o'clock pumped ship, considerable oil came with the water quite a hulk somewhere. Midnight full & by W.M. at daylight a sail & 1st off her bow heaved to E. 1 o'clock Port watch on deck, took and heaved E. by S by the wind. The sail astern. P.M. Commences with strong wind and cloudy weather. Ship heaving E. by S. Menman Island ahead. Gull-piper off her bow. M. L. 1st off weather squally. At 3 o'clock touched a sail M. L. 1st a signal for the Capt. to come aboard. Midnight full & by in company with the M. L. 1st. W.M. cloudy and moderate. 1 o'clock Starboard watch on deck employed. saw Gull-piper & 1st off her bow.
