 ahead. 1 o'clock Starboard watch on deck.

Lat 1-20 Long 82-41
 Remarks on Saturday Aug 21st
 P.M. Moderate and quite pleasant. Put water on
 deck. At 2 o'clock spot the No. 11 & Ohio
 Midnight full of fog. A.M. Ohio & No. 11 visible both
 in sight. At 1 o'clock saw a sail off weather quarter
 Put water on deck employed at washing ship.

Lat 1-23 North Long 82-52
 Remarks on Sunday Aug 22nd
 P.M. Clearing a fine breeze from N.E. Ship heading
 E. Ohio off the beam. No. 11 & weather quarter
 Starboard watch on deck employed at washing ship
 Midnight full of fog. A.M. 1 o'clock Starboard watch on
 deck. Ohio off the beam. No. 11 off weather quarter.

Lat 1-30 North Long 83-13
 Remarks on Monday Sept 1st
 P.M. Commences with a moderate wind. Ship heading
 E. S. E. by the wind. No. 11 & Ohio stern. About ten
 miles off the beam. At 2 o'clock saw Menman Island 150 steps in
 beam. Midnight full of fog. A.M. at daylight North head
 of Allman bearing S.E. No. 11 & Ohio in sight.

Lat 1-02
 Remarks on Tuesday Sept 2nd
 P.M. Moderate wind. No. 11 head in sight. Starboard
 watch on deck. At 2 o'clock spot the No. 11 & Ohio
 Midnight by the wind. A.M. light breeze and a
 strong current. Menman bearing N.W. by N. about 30 miles
 No. 11 & Ohio stern. 1 o'clock Starboard watch on deck employed
 on sail off the beam. At 10 o'clock a moderate
 wind ship heading E. by the wind. Saw English
 Lat 1-14 North Long 83-35

Remarks on Wednesday Sept 3rd
 P.M. Clearing a moderate wind. Ship heading
 E. S. E. by the wind. Put water on deck. At 1
 o'clock signalled a ship. 2 sails off to beam.
 Moderate through the night. A.M. No. 11 off
 weather quarter. Abington Island off weather beam
 1 o'clock put water on deck.

 P.M. Moderate weather. Ship heading E. by the
 wind. Starboard watch on deck employed. At
 sundown Abington off weather beam. Midnight
 full of fog. A.M. 1 o'clock Starboard watch on deck. At 2
 o'clock signalled a ship. supposed to be the Beland. At 11
 o'clock ship Cleopatra
 27 hours 450 lbs.

 Remarks on Saturday Sept 6th
 P.M. Moderate & pleasant. Ship heading E.
 Starboard watch on deck. At 2 o'clock Capt. Cleveland
 came aboard from No. 11. Midnight full of fog
 A.M. at 2 o'clock squally and rainy. 1 o'clock
 Starboard watch on deck employed. saw Ginkgo.
 Lat 1-16 North Long 84-02

Remarks on Sunday Sept 7th
 P.M. Clearing a fine breeze. Ship heading E. S. E.
 by the wind. No. 11 & Ohio stern. Put water on deck
 employed. weather thick and cloudy. At 1 o'clock
 tacked head. At 6 o'clock tacked head E. S.
 E. took in M. L. galantail. Midnight few passing
 squalls with rain. A.M. at daylight No. 11 & Ohio
 in quarter long dist off. A ship off weather beam
 on the return track. 1 o'clock. Put water on deck
