

1881 Onward Bark Cienow.

Sun 27

All hands can go ashore if they like. All gone but Almon. Myself the Hake, Steward took. Third Mate took one boatload three men Onward. Went to bed for the night. All hands come. Almon been on shore. Three men came on board gave principle to them. Almon been on shore twice. Our clothes come up board today. Threw out bed-quilt. slept some. finished getting water.

Tue 28

Almon gone on shore. Gave liberty to Almon board watch to day. Mended clothes.

Wed 30

Almon come on shore. He & P. been ashore walked around some called at his pass house.

Thu 31

Made to
Lunt-Lidia
Kath. Beaud

Almon been on shore. Discharged M. Jones. He being sick. Almon gave him tobacco, a hat, pair trousers, 1 wooden shirt, 1 cotton shirt, 2 pairs shoes. P. gave him a calico bedspread. 2 yds cambric 7 yds striped linen 6 yds bleached cotton cloth. M. Jones sent me 12 bottles put mine. Two years ago to day since we were married Almon gave me 10 pair of American Pigeons. A gentleman from shore sent me a box of pickles. Mended two letters. Took the anchor at 4 P.M. for sea come to anchor 2 or 3 miles off shore.

Sat 1

Took the anchor and beat off shore at 10 A.M. Mended in bedquilt.

Sat 2

Almon at work on pigeon house. lowered two boats at little after 5 P.M. but the thought there were sperm whales on our lee quarter but found to be killer boats come on board at dark.

Sun 3

Getting a little breeze. Pre written in Annis letter.

Mon 4

Commenced
to copy
letter

Mended Almon's pants.

Tue 5

Finished copying letter. Almon at work repairing boat.

Wed 6

Remained on bedquilt. Almon at work on boat.

Thu 7

Almon still at work on boat.

Fri 8

Almon at work on boat. Finished my bedquilt.

Sat 9

Almon at work on boat. cut one out two aprons swept bedding room. both pigeons sick.

Sun 10

Commenced a letter to Ann & Lizzie Almon is writing below.

Mon 11

Gave me out a pair of drawers.

Tue 12

Saw the Island of St. Helena at 10 A.M. Dried on clothes. Dried iron all night. Saw a merchant ship.

Wed 13

Ran down off the harbor Almon & I went on shore. Mr. Haines, Nigar, Van team, Galen & Adams. Handers, Harris & Birch. Reef at anchor. Stopped at the Consulate.

Thu 14

Went out shopping asked Lizzie Stuart to go with me. I bought me a black hat 2/6 at 5/11.

Fri 15

Being good Friday no business was done. Had the Doctor, Bay & Grunk, despatched.

Sat 16

Almon & I arrived on board at 2 P.M. and started for the Western Ground. Mrs. Hays died Feb 11. Had left a baby 1 week old. Mrs. Bandy baby died three hours she died soon after. her remains went home by the Lottie Beaud. Mrs. Shellest & Baby were passengers.

Sun 17

Resting today.

Mon 18

Commenced to cut out silk squares.

Tue 19

Worked on silk work.

Wed 20

Washed out Almon's stockings washed on silk work.

Thu 21

Worked on silk work.

Fri 22

Washed calico clothes. Having my warm blanket. Worked on silk work.
