S. by W. with all sail set.  
Employed on rigging-sheathing decks &c.

Wednesday All of this day moderate trades from E &  
17<sup>th</sup> Course S. by W. All sail set. Saw from aloft  
2 sails - hauled in the studsails - sheathing  
decks &c.  
Lat Obs. 13° 23'  
Long Chm. 32° 54'

Thursday First part of this day moderate trades  
18<sup>th</sup> from E. & E. by S. Course S. by W. with all upper  
sail set. M. part fresh breezes & squalls from  
W. Latter part more moderate & from E. & E.  
Employed on various jobs.  
Lat Obs. 10° 30'  
Long Chm. 32° 50'

Friday First part moderate breezes from E. S. E. to  
19<sup>th</sup> S. E. & squalls - Course S. by W. At 6 P.M. hauled  
in studsails. M. part light breezes & squalls.  
Latter part fresh breezes from E. S. E. & pleasant  
Lat Obs. 8° 11'  
Long Chm. 32° 45'

Saturday First part fresh breezes & M. & Latter parts more

Sunday First part fresh Easterly trades. At night squalls  
21<sup>st</sup> with wind from S. E. Steering by the wind  
to the S. S. W.  
M. & Latter part fresh breezes from S. E. & clear.  
Clipper Ship. Great Republic passed us 3 miles  
to windward carrying 3 Staysails - we nothing  
at above Staysails.  
Lat Obs. 3° 03'  
Long Chm. 33° 33'

Monday First part fresh trades from S. E. & clear.  
22<sup>nd</sup> Steering by the wind to the S. S. W. M. & L.  
part moderate breezes -  
Lat Obs. 1° 06'  
Long Chm. 34° 42'

Tuesday First part light & M. & Latter parts fresh  
23<sup>rd</sup> breezes from S. E. & S. E. by S. Steering by the  
wind to the S. S. W. Employed in setting  
up rigging & lashing aloft cutting punkarts.  
Lat Obs. 43' South  
Long Chm. 35° 43' W.

Wednesday First part fresh breezes from S. E. with clear  
24<sup>th</sup> weather. Steering by the wind to the S. S. W.  
M. & Latter parts strong breezes from S. E. by E.  
took in Fore & L. Topgallants & Fly-jib.

Long Chm. 36° 21'
