Day 1st 1857 All of this day moderate trades from E. S. E. to E. & pleasant. Steering by the wind to the S^d. All sail set. Saw land on the beam 20 miles dist. Saw several "Catamarans" saw 3 sails bound N^d.

2nd All of this day moderate trades from Est. Course S. by W. with all sail set. Employed setting up head-stays &c. Commenced after 7 P.M. S. by W.

3rd All of this day light trades from E. S. E. employed on rigging. 4 P.M. lowered & exercised the boats crews.

4th All of this day moderate trades from E. S. E. & pleasant. Course S. by W. Saw 4 sails steering by the wind to the N^d.

5th All of this day moderate trades from N. E. & pleasant. Saw several sails in various directions. At 6 P.M. spoke & engaged with Bark Sr Franklin, Russell, of Newport 54 days out on Blackfish.

6th All of this day moderate N. E. trades. Course S. S. W. with all sail set. Studdsails &c. saw a Bark standing to the N^d.

7th All of this day light trades from N. S. E. with overcast weather. Course S. S. W. with all sail set. Employed in making spun-yarn &c.

Lat Obs. 22° 49'

Saturday

8th First part moderate trades from N. E. Course as above. 7 P.M. course S. W. shifted over studdsails. Employed baling yarn &c.

Sunday

9th All of this day fresh breezes from N. N. E. & cloudy weather. Course S. W. with all sail set. Employed at various jobs.

10th First part fresh breezes from N. N. E. & pleasant weather. Course S. W. with all sail set. In part more moderate & wind veering to the W^d. Hauled in the studdsails & braced up. Latter part wind from S^d with thick weather. At 8 A.M. tacked to the S. W. -
