 Saturday, Sunday
 Jan 11th 1857. First part strong breeze from S. E. & stormy - took in topgallants, & double reefed the topsails. M. part a strong breeze & clear weather. Latter part more moderate breeze all sail. - Saw 2 sails.

Sunday Am.
 12th First part fresh breeze & squally from S. E. steering by the wind to the N. W. with all sail set. One sail in company on its beam saw to leeward a shoal of Blackfish run off a whale for them thinking at first they were whales. M. & Latter parts fine breeze from S. E. course S. W. by S. At 8 Am. changed colors with a French Bark.

Tues.
 Monday First & M. parts fine breeze as above course
 13th do. One bark in sight. Saw white-water. Latter parts fresh breeze & squally. At 9 A. M. saw several sperm-whales very much scattered & all going quick in various directions. At 10 Am. lowered 3 boats & chased to windward till noon - lost run of them & came aboard

 On Her Papage & Capt. Horn April 1858
 Wednesday
 14th First part fresh breeze from E. N. E. & clear weather. At 1 P.M. lowered again for more whales. At 3 P.M. 13. Boat struck & L. & H. boats some after to the same whale some the H. & 13. boats were stern L. 13 being late dark & then cut - M. & L. parts light air from N. E. & pleasant. Cruising in various directions to find the whale supposing him dead saw nothing - employed in fitting & repairing boats.

Lat Obs. 34° 58' S.
 Long Obs. 49° 49' W.

Wednesday Thurs.
 15th All of this day moderate breeze from N. E. & pleasant weather. P.M. cruising in various directions to find the whale - saw Killas & Crampfuss M. & Latter parts course S. E. - saw five sails. Changed colors with a Portuguese Brig. Repairing boats &c.

Lat Obs. 36° 25'

Friday
 Thursday
 16th First part light breeze from N. E. & pleasant course S. E. W. with all sail set. Still sails &c. saw one sail. M. & Latter parts fresh breeze from do. & cloudy - employed fitting boats making spun-yarn &c.
