

Remarks on Board Addison April 1857

Saturday
July 31st

Came in with moderate breeze from N. to N. N. W. with fog & rain. Steering by the wind to the S. S. W. 4 P.M. put up top-sails & do. the wind & storm increasing double uped the top-sails, Middle the same. Latter part wind increasing & squally from N. S. W.

Lat Obs. 58° 39'
Long Obs. 62° 33'

Sunday
February 1st 1857.

Came in with strong wind from N. S. W. & squally. Steering by the wind to the S. under Course & double uped top-sails. 2 P.M. it blowing in in a square took in sail to a clove uped M. top-sails. Spruce &c. - more ship to the N. W. M. the same.

Latter part moderating pleasant. made all sail heading N. N. W. then tacked to the S. W.

Long Obs. 63° 33'

Monday First part fine breeze from N. & tolerably good weather. Steering by the wind to the S. W. with all sail set. 6 P.M. took in top-sails M. & Latter part fresh breeze from N. to N. N. W. - some fog. Saw Porpoises.

Lat Obs. 59° 08'
Long Obs. 66° 21'
" Lunar 65° 50'

Near Cape Horn February 1857.

Tuesday At 12.30 a shift of wind to the S. W. 3rd tacked to the W. all sail set. with clear & pleasant weather. M. & Latter moderate & very unsteady wind from N. to S. W. At 2 P.M. tacked to the S. S. W. 6 do. tacked to the N. W. 11 do again to the S. W. Saw Porpoises - Broke out main-hatchway for water.

Lat Obs. 58° 12'
Long Obs. 67° 13'

Wednesday
4th

First part light breeze from W. & pleasant Steering by the wind to the S. W. with all sail set. Saw Porpoises. M. part moderate breeze from N. N. W. & cloudy. Latter part light breeze from do. & from N. W. Steering by the wind to the S. W.

Lat Obs. 58° 58'
Long Obs. 69° 36'
