

1857 Remarks on Board Ship Adonis.

Friday 20th First part light or moderate breeze from N. S. W. to S. trying to get up to Messafurus At sunset the island being 15 miles to the windward gave it up & kept off our course N. by W. Saw two ships under the lee of the land - saw also some finbacks. - Middle & latter parts fine breeze from S. S. E. Studdails set.

Long 4 P.M. per Obs. 79° 33'

Saturday 21st Come in with fine breeze from S. E. by S. & pleasant - Course N. by W. Saw Grampus also one ship on S. beam steering N. by E. - Middle & latter parts fresh breeze from do. Course N. S. W. saw nothing

Lat Obs 28° 57'
Long 4 P.M. per Obs. 80° 17'

Sunday 22nd First part fresh breeze from S. E. by S. & pleasant Course N. by W. after 4 P.M. steering for St. Felix island. - Middle & latter parts wind S. S. E. - At 3 A.M. came to the wind & lay till daylight expecting to see the land but passed to the westward of it without seeing it.

Monday 23rd Come in with fine breeze from S. E. by S. Course N. S. W. with all sail set. - Middle & latter parts the same - Wash-day -

Tuesday 24th First part fine breeze from S. E. cloudy w. Course N. S. W. with all sail set. - Middle & latter parts the same. employed at various jobs. baling yarns &c. Lat Obs 20° 38' S. Long

Wednesday 25th First part moderate trade from S. E. & cloudy Course N. S. W. with all sail set. - Middle & latter parts the same - employed in turning in & setting up M. rigging.

Lat Obs 17° 56' S

Thursday 26th First part fine breeze from S. E. & pleasant Course N. S. W. with all sail set. - Middle & latter parts light breeze from do. All hands employed P.M. making new lanyards & setting up fore & M. rigging.

Lat Obs 15° 53'

Friday 27th First part light breeze & pleasant from S. S. E. Course N. S. W. - all sail set. - Middle & latter parts the same - saw Killers - All hands afternoons employed turning in & setting up rigging.

Lat Obs 14° 11'

Saturday 28th First part light trade from S. S. E. very smooth & pleasant. Course N. S. W. with all sail set. Middle the same. Latter part light air from S. E. & pleasant saw a fin-back - All hands afternoons.
