

1857 Remarks on Board Ship Addison

Sunday Come in with light air from N. E. & pleasant
March 1st At 4 P.M. a moderate breeze from S. E. &
Cloudy - Course N. W. by N. with all sail
set. Middle & latter parts moderate
breezes from E. some squally.

Lat Obs. 10° 40' S.
Long 4 P.M. per Chron 85° 01' W.
" " " " " Lunar 83° 22'

Monday First part moderate breezes from E. S. E.
2nd & Cloudy - Course N. W. by N. with all sail
set - Saw "Sulphur Bottoms" and a fin back.
Middle & latter parts the same. Wash day

Lat. Obs. 8° 09' S.

Tuesday First part moderate breezes from S. E.
3rd & Clear, w. Course after 4 P.M. N. W. ships
over studd-sail - enlarging the Gally.
M. & latter parts the same - hove out
for hatch for water.

Lat Obs. 5° 38'

Wednesday First part light breezes from S. E. &
4th pleasant. Course N. W. At 1 P.M. rose
& lounded for a shoal of Blackfish - got
one - hoisted him in & kept off our course
again. - Middle the same. At 7 A.M.
lounded for Blackfish got 3. got them in
& kept off our course. At 10 A.M. wind
fresh from N. heading N. N. W.

Off Coast of Peru Feb. 1857.

Thursday Come in with fresh breezes from N. at 2
Feb. 5 P.M. lounded for Blackfish - got nothing
at 4 do. wind N. N. E. course N. W. -
Middle the same - Latter part light breezes
from N. E. - saw nothing.

Lat Obs. 4° 00'

Friday First part light breezes from N. E. to E. at
Feb 6 3 P.M. lounded for a shoal of Blackfish
got 2 hoisted them in & kept off our course
Middle & latter parts light breezes from E. S. E.
employed on rigging & boiling our Black
fish. - Saw Champises.

Lat Obs. 3° 08'

Long 4 P.M. per Chron 90° 25'

Saturday First part light breezes from E. S. E. & pleasant
7th Course N. W. Saw fin backs & Blackfish.
Middle & latter parts the same. Employed
on rigging.

Lat Obs. 2° 18'

90° 30' 4 P.M.

Sunday First part light breezes from E. S. E. & pleasant
8th Course as above till 3 P.M. then & after N. -
Middle & latter parts light air from E. making
slow progress to the N.

Lat Obs. 1° 35'

Long 4 P.M. per Chron 91° 44'

Monday First part light air from E. & Calms - heading
9th N. - lounded a boat & found 1 knot current setting
to the N. N. W. Middle & latter parts light air
variable & Calms - At 7 A.M. caught a *Piemont*
fish at 10 do lounded for Blackfish without success
Wash days.
