 Middle & latter parts the same.
 Employed on various jobs painting &c

Monday First part fine trades from E. N. E.
 13th & pleasant - Course N. by E.
 Middle & latter parts light trades from E.
 employed at various jobs about the ship
 repaired m. royal.

 Long 4 P.M. per Chs. $151^{\circ} 01' W.$

Tuesday First part light trades from E. & pleasant
 14th Course N. by E. with all sail set.
 Middle part wind S. E. latter do
 moderate from S. course N.
 set up head-stay.

For Sandwich Islands 1857

Wednesday Comes in with moderate wind from
 April 15th S. course N. by E. - Middle the same.

Latter part light wind variable & squally - at
 daylight got a glimpse of Oahu to the S. of us
 At 10 A.M. saw Maui for a moment bearing
 N. S. W. estimated the dist. 40 or 50 miles.
 Changed colors with an English topsail schooner
 steering N.

Lat Obs. $21^{\circ} 01' N.$

Thursday Comes in with wind & w. as above - At 2 1/2 P.M.
 16th a strong squall from N. took in topgallants &
 fly-jib & stunsail N. S. W. till 6 P.M. then wore
 ship to the Eastward & double reefed the topsail.
 At midnight wore ship to the N. some rain.
 Latter part fresh breeze from N. to N. N. W. at
 7 A.M. made all sail heading N. by E. with a
 heavy swell from N. W. At 11 E.M. saw the E.
 point of Maui bearing N. S. W. dist. 40 miles.

Lat Obs. $20^{\circ} 56'$

Friday First part fresh breeze from N. to N. N. E. &
 17th cloudy & thick over the land. steering by the wind
 to the N. W. with all sail set. At 7 P.M.
 Centrif part of Maui bore S. W. 15 miles dist.
 bent the chains - Lay off & on through the
 night - At daylight run down for the
 passage with light airs N. E. At noon
 we were right in the passage.
