

Remarks on Board Addison 1857

Friday May 11th All of this day fine breeze from S. E. to S. S. E. & pleasant steering by the wind to the N. W. employed in repairing boat &c. Released Edmund Lighten & James McEwen upon their promise of returning to duty & behaving themselves.

Saturday First part fine breeze from S. E. & pleasant repairing boat. Released Johnson from irons & sent him to his duty. Middle & latter parts moderate breeze from S. steering by the wind to the N. N. W.

Lat. Obs. 27° 47' N.
Long. 4 P.M. per Chron.

Sunday First part moderate breeze from S. & pleasant steering by the wind to the N. N. W. employed in repairing boat &c. Toward & visited an old Log. to windward. Middle & latter parts moderate breeze from E. N. E. steering by the wind to the N. At 8 A. M. rose a sail ahead steering as we are.

Lat Obs. 29° 10' N.
Long 4 P.M. per Chron.

Monday First part fresh breeze from E. N. E. to S. E. 4th & cloudy. At 6 P.M. came up with & spoke Ship Clinton, Cleveland & St. Badina 7 days from Oahu for Kodiak. Gained for 12 an hour. At 7 do furl'd fore & S. top gallants & 4th jib. Middle & latter parts the same. Employed in repairing boat.

Lat Obs. 31° 48' N.

From S. Islands to Kodiak 1857

Tuesday First part fresh breeze from E. with passing clouds. steering by the wind to the N. under whole topsails. Course & jib. Saw fin-backs. Middle & latter parts strong breeze from E. S. E. to S. E. steering S. E.

Lat Obs.

Wednesday First part of this day strong breeze from S. E. & cloudy - steering S. E. under double reefed topsails. Middle part the same Course S. by E. Latter more moderate & thick fog - made all sail. Employed in repairing boat.

No Obs.

Thursday Comes in with moderate breeze from S. S. E. foggy - Course S. by E. sail as above. Middle & latter parts light air from S. & fog & rain.

No Obs.

Friday Comes in with light air from S. with fog & rain - Course S. by E. with all sail set. Employed in repairing boat &c. Middle part light air variable & rainy - Latter part light breeze from E. & partially clear. Saw Sulphur bottoms & at noon lowered 2 boats for one without success.
