Friday

June 12<sup>th</sup> All of this day light air from N. to N. E. steering by the wind to the E<sup>th</sup> with all sail set. 2 P.M. finished boiling. Employed scraping Bone. 4 A.M. saw 3 Right whales going down to the N<sup>th</sup> did not lower. Comm. Employed stowing down oil.

Saturday First part light air from N. &amp; cloudy.

13<sup>th</sup> steering by the wind to the E<sup>th</sup> stowing down oil. Saw Fin-backs.

M. & Latter parts light air from N<sup>th</sup> & cloudy. Brought out & exposed our sperm oil.

Sunday First part light air from N. &amp; pleasant

14<sup>th</sup> finished cooking & stowing down our oil.

M. & Latter parts light air & calms - working toward Ross Island - saw Fin-backs & Grampuses.

Monday First part moderate breeze from N. N. E.

15<sup>th</sup> E. & pleasant. steering by the wind to the N. W. under all sail. Saw Fin-backs Sulphur bottoms, Hump-backs & Grampuses. 7 P.M. took in 3/4 pt & 1/2 of gallants. Daylight made all sail, pleasant air. Saw many Fin-backs, Sulphur bottoms & Hump-backs.

## Bound North Eastward June 1857.

Tuesday

June 16<sup>th</sup> First part moderate breeze from N. & pleasant. Saw Sulphur bottoms, Hump-backs & Fin-backs. lowered boats for a Sulphur bottom without success. M. & Latter parts light air variable & calms - some rain. Saw Fin-backs.

At 6.00.

Wednesday

17<sup>th</sup> First & M. parts light wind Eastward & variable - working to the E<sup>th</sup> saw a sail to the N. E. also saw a Fin-back. Latter part a gale from N. E. to E. N. E. & squally. At 4 A.M. saw Day's Island having N. W. dist 25 miles - with ship to the S<sup>th</sup> saw Sulphur bottoms, also one ship.

Thursday

18<sup>th</sup> First part strong wind from E. N. E. & squally. 6 P.M. spoke ship Ch<sup>o</sup> Canoe Parsons of N. London 2<sup>nd</sup> time this season. & one Hump-back. - saw Fin-backs. M. & Latter parts light air from N. E. & pleasant steering by the wind to the E<sup>th</sup>.

19<sup>th</sup> All of this day light air variable & calms with pleasant weather - working to the N. E. Saw Fin-backs & Hump-backs. Two sails in sight - one of them the Ch<sup>o</sup> Canoe.
