Monday
 July 6th First & M. parts moderate breeze & clear
 standing down oil. 7 P.M. spoke ship
 Lamblane Winslow just this season
 Latter part some fog - finished standing
 down oil - saw fin backs.

Lat Acct 58° 50'

Tuesday First part moderate breeze from S. & drizzly
 weather - scraping bottom, washing ship &c
 M. much the same 9 A.M. lowered for
 2 R. whales without success. Notes.

Wednesday I don't appear to have any in the
 8th "Log Book" & so I will ignore it here.

Thursday 9th First part strong breeze from S. E. with spurs
 of fog. 6 1/2 P.M. rose & lowered for a R.
 whale 1 1/2 miles to windward - 7 1/2 A.M.
 L. B. fastened but getting no chance to
 lance him cut off at 8 1/2 A.M. it being night
 & foggy & out of sight from the ship.
 M. & L. parts strong wind from dr. with thick
 rainy weather 7 A.M. ran a "gam" of 4
 R. whales off deck close to & 2 on L. beam
 which we lowered for but did not see after
 lowering. Notes.

Off St. Elias July 1857

Friday
 July 10th First part moderate breeze from S. E. &
 foggy. Saw whales going quick to the
 E. at 3 P.M. lowered for 3 going quick
 & could not overtake them. M. & Latter
 parts moderate breeze from N. & pleasant.
 Cruising in various directions - saw 3 backs.
 Lat Acct 58° 12'

Long 141

Saturday
 10th Commenced in with light air from N. & calm
 2 P.M. lowered for 2 R. whales without
 success - 6 A.M. lowered for one chance
 before coming aboard Cape - got nothing
 M. part moderate breeze from E. S. E.
 Latter part wind increased to a gale
 with thick rainy weather - saw 2 backs
 to the E. Notes.

Sunday
 11th All of this day a gale from E. S. E.
 with thick rainy weather - under
 12th Short sail heading to the S. Notes.

Monday
 12th First part gale abating & clearing up saw
 6 sails - 1 P.M. dropped down one boat
 for a whale close to the ship did not
 see him from the boat. 3 P.M. gale
 with ship. Good Return, King N.B. 11 A.M.
 M. & Latter parts moderate breeze from S. E.
 steering E. N. E. 9 A.M. lowered 2 boats
 for a R. whale going quick - did not
 get near him
