

# Remarks on Board Addison July 1857

Tuesday

July 14<sup>th</sup> First part moderate breeze from E. S. E. & squally steering to the S. E. several sails in sight - saw the land near Mt Fairweather dist. 30 miles. Saw also Hump & Fin-backs. 3 P.M. went ship to the S. N. Sunset shortened sail. Daylight made sail & steered in various directions - saw Fin-backs & Grampuses.  
 Lat 58° 42'  
 Long 140° 53'

Wednesday, First part light breeze from E. & from S. N. 15<sup>th</sup> Saw Fin-backs. M. & latter parts moderate breeze from N. N. E. steering in various directions, saw Sulphur bottoms, 10 A.M. lowered 2 boats for a cow & calf - S. 13 got on N. S. D. the other ends with boats fast.

Thursday, Moderate breeze & pleasant. 3 P.M. 16<sup>th</sup> got the whales to the ship & cut them in finishing at midnight -

Friday, All of this day light winds westerly - pleasant. 7 A.M. began boiling, steering to the E. & 8 A.M. lowered 3 boats for a R. whale. S. D. dived but did not fasten. 11 A.M. picked up a dead whale by the tail - have in his lips & part of the throat & let the rest go.

# Off Mt St Elias July 1857

Saturday

18<sup>th</sup> All of this day light breeze from N. S. N. & pleasant - steering N. E. - Boiling - saw Hump & Fin-backs.  
 Lat 58° 30'  
 Long 140° 05'

Sunday

19<sup>th</sup> Light winds from N. & pleasant, steering to the E. & boiling - 10 P.M. spoke ship John Howland, Meader 5 wh. 10 A.M. spoke ship Contest, Snellow, 6 wh. one of them ours. got our iron from her -  
 At 10.

Monday

20<sup>th</sup> All of this day light air from N. & Calms, steering in various directions saw Fin-backs. Boiling -  
 Lat 57° 55'

Tuesday

21<sup>st</sup> First part moderate breeze from N. & S. N. E. 8 1/2 P.M. lowered for 3 R. whales without success - one sail in sight. M. & latter parts moderate breeze from N. & most of the time thick. 9 A.M. spoke & gamed with ship Enterprise, 1 Brown of Nantucket 4 wh. At 10 steering down oil -

Wednesday

22<sup>nd</sup> All of this day moderate breeze from N. & cloudy. 7 P.M. finished steering down heading to the S. saw Fin-backs.  
 Lat 57° 27'
