

Remarks On Board Addison Aug 1837

Friday

Aug 21st First part light airs from N. N. W. & Calms - thick fog - Caught a few Cod-fish, saw two R. whales through the fog going to the N. N. W. & latter part light winds from S. working off slowly to the N. W. 9 am fog lifted - saw nothing
 Lat 58° 17'
 Long 164° 00'

Saturday All of this day strong winds from E. S. E. & S. E. overcast weather. 11 am double reefed the topsails - Cruising back & forth
 Lat 57° 30'
 Long 164° 15'

Sunday First part strong gales from E. S. E. & rising 2nd weather - under short sail. 11 am gale abated to a calm & so continues -
 Lat 57° 01'
 Long 164° 40'

Monday First & M. parts calm & cloudy. 2 pm. Toward for a R. whale going quick to the E. could not overtake him. Latter part light air from N. E. to N. 8 am. Toward for a R. whale going quick to the N. E. could not catch him
 Lat 56° 56'
 Long 164° 10'

Tuesday Comes in with moderate breeze from N. to N. W. 25th heading to the N. E. 6 pm. the wind had increased to a gale & we were under short sail - & so continues for the day - rainy
 Saw many Hump & Fin-backs.
 Noobs.

In Bristol Bay Aug. 1837

Wednesday

Aug 26th First & M. part fresh gale from N. N. to N. with rainy weather & how to. heading to the N. E. Latter part the same
 Saw many Hump & Fin-backs. Noobs.

Thursday All of this day light winds from S. & 27th cloudy. 3 1/2 pm. Toward for a R. whale which W. B. got & took alongside at dark got ready & began cutting finishing at 10 am. - saw two other whales going quick.
 Lat 56° 50'

Friday All of this day moderate breeze from N. & 28th 3 pm. began boiling - daylight saw 14 ships 4 of them boiling & 6 am. Toward for a R. whale going quick to the N. E. which L. B. got. so ends boat off.

Saturday First & M. parts strong wind from N. to 29th S. S. W. & cloudy - boat off hauling up a sinking whale. 3 pm. got him alongside & got ready & began cutting - cut all night the wind blowing a gale finishing at 8 am. - Latter part wind light & unsteady boiling - a few sails in sight.
 Lat 56° 59'

Sunday All of this day strong wind & part of 30th the time to gale from N. N. & squally. under short sail - boiling - saw one whale & 2 ships
 Lat 56° 50'
