

Remarks On Board Addison Oct

Wednes. Oct 7<sup>th</sup> 1837 All of this day light airs from N. & pleasant. Course S. by E 1/2 E. - Coasting & bundling ton & jolting on rigging. Lat 30° 19' Long 149° 25'

Thurs. 8<sup>th</sup> First & M. part light winds from N. & pleasant. Course S. by N. - Latter part light airs variable with light rain squalls. Employed on rigging washing ship etc. Lat 28° 41'

Friday 9<sup>th</sup> First part light airs from N. E. & pleasant. Course S. S. W. M. & Latter part light airs from S. E. hauled in studdsails & traced up the yards - employed in washing ship & jolting on rigging. Lat 27° 48' Long 149° 43'

Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> All of this day light winds & variable mostly from S. S. E. - Cleaning ship & jolting rigging - Lat 27° 02' Long 151° 24'

Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> First part light airs variable & calms. M. & Latter parts fine breeze S. E. & pleasant. Steering S. S. W. all sail set. Lat 25° 33' Long 152° 50'

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Monday Oct 12<sup>th</sup> All of this day fine breeze from S. E. part of the time squally - all sail set. Steering S. S. W. employed on rigging.

Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> All of this day fine breeze from E. to E. S. E. & fine weather - Course after 4 P.M. S. by N. 1/2 W. 10 A.M. saw Ranai on E. beam 50 miles dist - employed on rigging. Lat 22° 04'

Wednes. 14<sup>th</sup> First part light airs from S. steering by the wind to the S. W. 3 P.M. saw Oahu & end bearing S. S. W. 40 miles dist - sunset 30 miles - wore ship to the E. & hauled up courses. M. & Latter parts moderate breeze from E. at daylight sun off for Oahu. At noon Diamond head in sight.

Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> First part light breeze from E. running down for the harbor - got the anchors off the bows. 5 P.M. Pilot & steamboat came off & took us in to an anchor at dusk. Latter part hauled alongside of ship Carnett & Jessie of Boston & got ready to discharge Ore

Friday 16<sup>th</sup> All of this day pleasant weather Disch. Ore
