

Remarks On Board Addison Oct 1857

Saturday

Oct 17th All of this day light trades & pleasant. All hands employed disch^y Oil - also shipped 886 lbs of Bone on board ship "John Land" of Boston.

Sunday

Oct 18th All of this day light trades & pleasant. All hands but ship kepers ashore.

Monday

Oct 19th All of this day fresh trades & pleasant. Employed disch^y Oil - disch^y & trim. Desmot on account of "Rupture" having been laid up for the last 2 mos.

Tuesday

Oct 20th Moderate trades & pleasant - disch^y Oil.

Wednesday

Oct 21st All of this day moderate trades & pleasant. finished shipping oil having shipped as per Gauge 19661 gals whale oil & 1810 gals sperm oil. Latter part hauled off from H & Jessie & moved ship.

Thursday

Oct 22nd All of this day fresh trades & pleasant. Employed in stowing hold & getting off water -

Lying At Honolulu Oct 1857.

Friday

Oct 23rd Strong trades & pleasant. All hands employed in painting ship & other jobs. Cooper setting up shooks.

Saturday

Oct 24th Strong trades & pleasant. All hands employed painting ship &c Cooper setting up shooks - Disch^y Oil, a seaman Charles W. Beecher on Doctor's recommendation supposing him to have Consumption - Also shipped a cook who came aboard & went to work in place of the other whose term of service expires this day & is disch^y.

Sunday

Oct 25th Strong trades & pleasant - all hands but ship kepers ashore.

Monday

Oct 26th Moderate trades & pleasant - all hands employed in stowing hold painting ship setting up shooks &c. Disch^y 2 Kanakas "Pack" & "John" one seaman Emanuel Lyra shipped & joined the ship. The Cook shipped as above not proving good was disch^y.

Tuesday

Oct 27th Moderate trades & pleasant. All hands employed getting off water - stowing hold &c. Thos C. Weeks directed Mr Baxter 2nd Officer disch^y.
