

Remarks on Board Addison Dec 1stTuesday
Dec 1st

First part moderate breeze from E. to N.E. & pleasant. Course N. by N. with all sail set, employed in repairing foremast. Middle & latter parts the same.

27° 35'

Wednesday
Dec 2nd First part moderate breeze from E. to E. & cloudy. Course N. by S. finished repairing & bent the foremast.

Middle & latter parts the same - some light fog at night.

Thursday
Dec 3rd

First part of this day moderate breeze from E. Course N. by E. with all sail set. Middle & latter parts the same Course N. S. W.

Friday
Dec 4th

Came in with moderate breeze from E. to E. with cloudy weather. Course N. S. W. with all sail set. Saw nothing of note - employed in fitting new lights & foot ropes to the fore-mast. When shall we capture a sperm whale, I wonder? - will please look on next page & see if you can be the account of our doing so.

Middle & latter parts fresh breeze from N. & cloudy. Course N.

Near French Rock Dec 1857

Saturday
Dec 5th

First part fresh breeze from E. to E. & cloudy. Course N. with all sail set. At sunset judging ourselves 40 miles E. of Sunday island we doubled up the topsails & jib, & came to the wind heading to the S. E. struck a porpoise but lost him & the iron also.

At 7 A.M. kept off N. set up fore topmast rigging &c.

Long Obs. 178° 10'

Sunday
Dec 6th

First part fresh breeze from E. & pleasant the day weather. Course S. at 6 P.M. from Sunday island S. by E. 12 miles dist. got within 6 or 8 miles & then ship & shortened sail.

At 8 A.M. got off the bar & put in a boat to see if we could get wood. Found 3 families - 2 of them lately from St. James island living there.

Monday
Dec 7th

At 1 P.M. but came aboard found we could get wood for \$6 per cord bargained for some, but the coming on to blow so strong & raining that we gave it up for this P.M. took in sail to double up the topsails & started off shore to the S. E.

Middle & latter parts strong winds & rain. Gave off & on waiting for smoother weather.
