

Remarks On Board Addison Decr 1857

Tuesday
Decr 15th

All of this day strong winds from N. & S. & S. W. At 5 P.M. got near Goat or Macaulay's Island & sent in L. & M. boats to see what was to be seen - I climbed up the precipice & had a view of about 100 goats & some hogs - got a fall on the rocks coming to the boat - skinned my forehead & fingers some & came aboard at dark bringing two hogs we shot. Lay off & on all night & in the morning went in again with two boats.

Wednesday First part strong winds from S.

18th Lying off & on - At 5 P.M. the boats came off bringing 3 goats one of them captured. While at about 12 down fish of various kinds I should judge there was 500 Goats on the island - a few hogs & some Rabbits. stood off to the E. & shortened sail. Latter part strong winds from S. W. with passing clouds - heading S. S. E.

Thursday

19th

First part strong winds from S. W. & Cloudy - steering by the wind to the S. S. E. at 7 P.M. took in M. topgallant & double reefed the Top sails. M. & Latter parts light winds from do & pleasant - at daylight made all sail - steering by the wind to the S. S. E. - saw nothing.

Friday
18th

First part light airs from N. S. W. & pleasant steering to the S. with all sail set. Middle part brisk wind from do. Latter part strong wind & squally. At 7 A.M. stood off E. S. E.

Saturday
19th

First part strong wind from S. W. with clear weather. Course E. S. E. with all sail set - M. & latter parts strong breeze from S. by W. with passing clouds. At 9 A.M. took in M. Topgallant. steering S. E. by E. Watched buoy as usual.

Sunday
20th

First part strong winds from S. S. W. clear weather steering S. E. by E. under whole Top sails & Canvas. At 6 P.M. set M. topgallant. M. & Latter parts light airs & Calms & pleasant. Lat Obs. 36° 53' S.

Monday
21st

First part light airs & Calms. M. & Latter parts fine breeze from N. W. & pleasant. Course S. E.

Lat Obs. 38° 10'
Long Obs. 178° 00'

Tuesday
22nd

First part fine breeze from N. W. & pleasant weather - Course S. E. Middle & Latter parts the same. employed in jobs on rigging & making spun yarn.

Lat Obs. 40° 04'
