

## Remarks on Board Addison January 1853

Wednesday

30<sup>th</sup> Comes in with a hard gale from N. N. W. & heavy sea, with passing clouds, lying as before heading N. W. At 5 P.M. saw a ship's burning before the wind - probably leaving this territory. At 6 P.M. we kept off N. E. & hauled the L. Topsyail, & set Foresail & a double reefed Fore Topsyail. - M. & Latter parts the same Course N. E. by N. at 9 A.M. set a close reefed L. Topsyail.

Thursday Comes in with a hard gale from N. N. W. 31<sup>st</sup> with passing squalls. Course N. N. E. under sail as above. At 1 A.M. more moderate stand N. & set jib & mainsail. Latter part wind N. turned the reef out of the Topsyails, mended the mast-heads but saw nothing

Long Obs. 141° 52'

Friday First part fresh breeze from N. to N. W. with 32 overcast weather & at 5 P.M. a little rain. turning by the wind to the N. E. At 7 P.M. kept off N. E. & set M. Topsyail. - M. part fresh breeze from N. N. W. & squally. took in M. Topsyail. morning some rain & wind in a squall from S. W. At 8 A.M. it cleared up & we made all sail M. Royal also. Ends with fresh breeze from S. W. & pleasant weather. Course E. by N.

## Barré Northward &amp; towards Sandwich Island

Saturday

January 23 First part fresh breeze from S. W. with pleasant weather - Course after 1 P.M. N. by E. - with all sail set. Saw a sea-kew. M. & Latter parts light breeze from do & fine weather. employed in repairing the Jib-jib. Lat Obs. 39° 49'. Johnson still in view. Long Obs.

Sunday First part light breeze from S. W. & fine weather. 24<sup>th</sup> Course N. by E. finished repairing & bent Jib-jib. M. & Latter parts light breeze from S. W. pleasant - Long course day.

Lat Obs. 38° 04'  
Long Obs. 135° 38'

Monday Comes in with light air from S. E. 25<sup>th</sup> steering N. by E. with all sail set & fanning along from 13 to 4 knots per hour. - M. part calm & light air variable. Latter part light breeze from N. E. steering by the wind to the N. E. & all sail out with pleasant weather. unbent Fore Topsyail to repair. Lat Obs. 3° 39'. Long Obs. 134° 23'.

Tuesday First part light breeze from N. W. & cloudy 26<sup>th</sup> steering by the wind to the N. E. & at 7 P.M. finished repairing & bent the Fore Topsyail. M. & Latter parts light breeze from N. N. W. Course N. by E. repaired the Jib-jib. Fore Topsyail. At 10 A.M. rose a ship on weather bow.
