

Remarks On Board Ship Addison

Wednesday

Jan. 27th First part light airs from N. S. W. steering by the wind to the N. by E. all sail set. One ship ahead & we gaining on her fast. M. & Latter parts the same. At 8 Am. spoke & engaged with ship *Sat. Maury*, Com. of *A. Bedford* whaler this season.

Thursday

28th First part light airs from N. W. to N. N. W. M. & pleasant - steering by the wind to the N. N. E. gaining till sunset with the *Sat. Maury*. M. & Latter part light breezes from N. W. to N. steering by the wind to the N. E. Sent down the mainsail for repairs.

Friday

29th Comes in with light breezes from N. W. & pleasant, steering by the wind to the N. E. *Sat. Maury* astern, employed in repairing the *M. Sade*. M. & Latter part moderate breezes from N. to N. W. steering by the wind to the N. E.

Saturday

30th First part moderate breezes from N. N. W. & pleasant - at 5 P.M. finished repairing & bent the mainsail. M. & Latter parts Calm. *Sat. Maury* in sight. Washed & dried our tops.

Long Obs. $128^{\circ} 47'$

Breeze Northward. January 1858

Sunday

31st First part Calm. saw *Crampships*. *Sat. Maury* in sight. Middle part light airs from S. E. came N. N. E. with all sail set. Latter part light breezes from S. E. & pleasant. Comm. after 7 Am. *Sat. Maury*. Set Lower & Topmast Studdsail Lat Obs. $31^{\circ} 04'$
Long Obs.

Monday

1st First part moderate S. E. trades & pleasant. Comm. N. N. W. with all sail set. M. part fresh breezes from E. hauled in the Lower Studdsail. Latter part much the same. At 9 Am. took in Topmast Studdsail & for topgallant sail. broke out for pipe shores & heads & set Copper at work setting them up. Lat Obs. $28^{\circ} 44'$
Long Obs. $126^{\circ} 16'$

Tuesday

2nd First part strong trades from E. & clear weather. One sail seen fasten from aloft probably the *Sat. Maury*, in our sail as above. M. & Latter parts fresh breezes & squally from N. E. Comm. N. N. W. when she will head it. Lat Obs. $26^{\circ} 10'$
Long Obs. $130^{\circ} 16'$

Wednesday

3rd First part fresh breezes from N. E. & cloudy steering by the wind to the N. N. E. with all sail set. At daylight saw *Pitcairn Island* bearing N. 13 miles dist. ran down & past it & then hauled our wind to the N. W. *Sat. Maury* in sight.
